**CERTIFICATE OF NO OBJECTION**

On December 6, 2019, the official committee of unsecured creditors (the “Committee”) filed the *Application to employ FTI Consulting, Inc. as Financial Advisor Application Pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2014(a) for Order Under Section 1103 of the Bankruptcy Code Authorizing the Employment and Retention of FTI Consulting, Inc. as Financial Advisor to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors Nunc Pro Tunc to November 6, 2019* [Docket No. 205] (the “FTI Retention Application”). The Retention Application contained the following negative notice language:

NO HEARING WILL BE CONDUCTED HEREON UNLESS A WRITTEN RESPONSE IS FILED WITH THE CLERK OF THE UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT AT 1100 COMMERCE ST # 1452, DALLAS, TX 75242 BEFORE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON DECEMBER 30, 2019, WHICH IS AT LEAST 24 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF SERVICE HEREOF.

ANY RESPONSE SHALL BE IN WRITING AND FILED WITH THE CLERK, AND A COPY SHALL BE SERVED UPON COUNSEL FOR THE MOVING PARTY PRIOR TO THE DATE AND TIME SET FORTH HEREIN. IF A RESPONSE IS FILED A HEARING MAY BE HELD WITH NOTICE ONLY TO THE OBJECTING PARTY.

IF NO HEARING ON SUCH NOTICE OR MOTION IS TIMELY REQUESTED, THE RELIEF REQUESTED SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE UNOPPOSED, AND THE COURT MAY ENTER AN ORDER GRANTING THE RELIEF SOUGHT OR THE NOTICED ACTION MAY BE TAKEN.

As of close of business on December 30, 2019, the Court's docket reflects that no responses or objections to the FTI Retention Application were filed. Additionally, no responses or objections were received by the undersigned counsel. The Committee therefore requests that the Court grant the relief requested in the Proposed Order that was filed contemporaneously with the FTI Retention Application.
