STATE OF MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY'S REPONSE IN OPPOSITION TO SECOND OMNIBUS OBJECTION (SUBSTANTIVE) OF PLAN ADMINISTRATOR TO CERTAIN PROOFS OF CLAIM

NOW COMES Michigan Department of Treasury (hereinafter Treasury) and in response to Second Omnibus Objection (Substantive) of Plan Administrator to Certain Proofs of Claim as it relates to the Michigan Department of Treasury's Proof of Claim (Claim No. 17) states as follows:

- 1. On March 24, 2020, Treasury filed Proof of Claim 435 in related matter *In re Red Steer, Inc.*, Case No. 19-12418-MFW. Claim 435 listed \$223.52 in priority unsecured debt in the form of interest owed on Michigan Sales Tax owed for the tax periods of January 2017 and December 2017. The claim also listed \$1,822.66 in general unsecured debt in the form of penalty owed on Michigan Sales Tax owed for the tax periods of January 2017 and December 2017.
- 2. On July 27, 2022, Treasury amended Proof of Claim 435. The amended claim lists \$219.48 in priority unsecured debt in the form of interest owed on Michigan Sales Tax owed for the tax periods of January 2017 and December 2017. The claim also lists \$682.40 in general unsecured debt in the form of penalty owed on Michigan
 - 3. Interest and penalties are owed on the above reference tax debt because



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although Debtor Red Steer ultimately paid the sales taxes owing, the sales taxes were

paid late. If sales taxes are paid late interest is owed on the late payments. As Sworn

Summary filed with Amended Proof of Claim 435 establishes, \$219.48 of the debt

owed is interest on tax debt. (See Ex. 1, Amended Proof of Claim 435.)

4. Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 507(a)(8)(G), interest owed on a tax debt is a penalty

entitled to priority treatment.

5. The Plan Administrator has sought in its Second Omnibus (Substantive)

Objection to Certain Proofs of Claim that Treasury's priority debt should be

reclassified to general unsecured debt rather than priority unsecured debt. No

legal reason has been provided for this change in treatment of Treasury's priority

unsecured debt other than to state that Treasury's claim should be reclassified

because the Plan Administrator "vehemently contends" that it should be and

sufficient proof of the debt does not exist. (R. 915, pps 4-5). However, both the

original Proof of Claim and Amended Proof of Claim 435 contain sworn statements

detailing the type of debt owed. No information has been produced to demonstrate

that Treasury's Sworn Summaries are incorrect or that Debtor Red Steer timely

filed is Sales Tax debt for the periods at issue.

WHEREFORE, for all the foregoing reasons, Michigan Department of Treasury

respectfully requests that the Plan Administrator's objection and request to reclassify

Treasury's priority unsecured debt be denied.
