Re: GMAC Mortgage, LLC's Request for Extension of Deadline to Respond in Adversary Proceeding *Kimber v. GMAC Mortgage, LLC, et al.*, Adversary No. 12-02045 (MG)

Dear Judge Glenn:

We are counsel to Residential Capital, LLC, GMAC Mortgage, LLC ("GMACM"), and their debtor affiliates (collectively, the "Debtors") in their jointly administered chapter 11 bankruptcy cases, Case No. 12-12020 (MG), and in the above-captioned adversary proceeding (the "Adversary Proceeding") initiated by Brian and Malinda Kimber (the "Plaintiffs"). As directed by the Court at the omnibus hearing held on December 20, 2012, the Debtors submitted an order extending the deadline for each of the named defendants to the Adversary Proceeding (the "Defendants") to answer or otherwise respond to the complaint filed by the Plaintiffs (the "Complaint") through and including February 4, 2013, which was entered by the Court on December 26, 2012 (ECF # 6).

We write to request the Court enter an order further extending the date by which all Defendants must answer or otherwise respond to the Complaint by approximately thirty days (until March 6, 2013), and rescheduling the pretrial conference to the next omnibus hearing date after the extended response date. The Debtors are requesting an extension in part to provide SilvermanAcampora LLP, appointed as special borrowers' counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (in such capacity "**Special Borrowers' Counsel**"), with additional time to reach out to the Plaintiffs, as had been discussed at the December 20th hearing. To date, Special Borrowers' Counsel has left multiple voice messages and sent a letter for Plaintiffs but has not yet received a response. The Debtors believe it is appropriate to further extend the response deadline to allow Plaintiffs time to respond to Special Borrowers' Counsel's inquiries and potentially engage in a constructive dialogue. Additionally, because the Complaint names a number of other Defendants including at least



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one current or former employee or agent, for purposes of administrative convenience the Debtors request that the Court extend the time for all Defendants to respond to the Complaint.

Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9006(b)(1), the Court may extend the time for any act required by the Bankruptcy Rules (with limited exceptions not relevant here) "for cause shown . . . with or without motion or notice." In addition to the attempts to reach Plaintiffs described above, Special Borrowers' Counsel has also attempted to contact Plaintiffs directly to request an extension, but has not yet obtained a response.¹

For the foregoing reasons, the Debtors respectfully request that the Court extend the defendants' deadline to answer or otherwise respond to the Complaint until March 6, 2013 and reschedule the pre-trial conference to the omnibus hearing scheduled on March 21, 2013 or such other date as the Court may set at its convenience. A proposed form of order granting such extension is enclosed.
