ORDER DENYING SECOND MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

On January 28, 2014, the Plaintiff filed an Emergency Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order (the “First Motion,” ECF Doc. # 3), seeking an order restraining certain parties from foreclosing on the Plaintiff’s home. The Court denied the First Motion because foreclosure of the plaintiff’s property had been postponed (ECF Doc. # 5). The Plaintiff now advances the Second Emergency Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order (the “Second Motion,” ECF Doc. # 10), again seeking to thwart a foreclosure of his home, now scheduled for April 28, 2014. The Plaintiff has not made a proper showing that he is entitled to the requested relief, so the Second Motion is **DENIED**.
