# NOTICE OF ADJOURNMENT OF CONFIRMATION HEARING AND SALE HEARING

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, on May 21, 2020, the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "Debtors") filed the Debtors' Motion Seeking Entry of an Order (A) Approving Bidding Procedures, (B) Scheduling an Auction and Sale Hearing, (C) Approving the Form and Manner of Notice Thereof, (D) Establishing Procedures for the Assumption and Assignment of Certain Executory Contracts and Leases, and (E) Granting Related Relief [Docket No. 18] (the "Sale Motion")² with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "Court") seeking, among other things, entry of an order (the "Sale Order") authorizing and approving: (a) the sale of the Debtors' Assets to Akorn Holdings Topco LLC (the "Stalking Horse Bidder"), free and clear of liens, claims, encumbrances, and other interests, except as set forth in the Stalking Horse APA, or an alternative asset purchase agreement with a Successful Bidder at auction (the "Sale"); and (b) the assumption and assignment of executory contracts and unexpired leases in connection therewith (collectively, the "Contracts").

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that, on May 26, 2020, the Debtors filed the *Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Akorn, Inc. and its Debtor Affiliates* [Docket No. 101] (as modified, amended, or supplemented from time to time, the "<u>Plan</u>") and the proposed *Disclosure Statement for Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Akorn, Inc. and its Debtor Affiliates* [Docket No. 102] (as modified, amended, or supplemented from time to time, the "<u>Disclosure Statement</u>").
