

# ORDER DIRECTING THE JOINT ADMINISTRATION OF THE DEBTORS' CHAPTER 11 CASES

This matter coming before the Court on the Motion of the Debtors for an Order

Directing the Joint Administration of Their Chapter 11 Cases [Dkt. 3] (the "Motion"),<sup>1</sup> filed by

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the debtors and debtors in possession in the above-captioned cases (together, the "Debtors");<sup>2</sup> the Court having reviewed the Motion and the First Day Declarations and having considered the statements of counsel and the evidence adduced with respect to the Motion at a hearing before the Court (the "Hearing"); the Court finding that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, (b) venue is proper in this district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409, (c) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b), (d) notice of the Motion and the Hearing was sufficient under the circumstances, (e) no other or further notice need be provided, (f) the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors' estates, their creditors, and other parties in interest, and (g) joint administration of the above-captioned Chapter 11 Cases for procedural purposes only is appropriate pursuant to Rule 1015(b) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and Rule 1015-1 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of North Carolina; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion, the First Day Declarations, and the Hearing establish just cause for the relief granted herein;

### IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.

2. The above-captioned Chapter 11 Cases are consolidated for procedural purposes only and shall be jointly administered. The Clerk of the Court shall maintain one file and one docket for these jointly administered cases, which file and docket for each chapter 11 case shall be the file and docket for Aldrich Pump LLC, Case No. 20-30608 (JCW).

3. Parties in interest are directed to use the Proposed Caption annexed hereto as Exhibit 1 when filing a pleading with the Court in these Chapter 11 Cases indicating that the

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pleading relates to the jointly administered Chapter 11 Cases of "Aldrich Pump LLC, *et al.*" The consolidated caption satisfies the requirements of section 342(c) of the Bankruptcy Code in all respects.

4. A docket entry shall be made on the docket for Murray Boiler LLC

substantially as follows:

An order has been entered in this case directing the procedural consolidation and joint administration of the chapter 11 cases of Aldrich Pump LLC and Murray Boiler LLC. The docket of Aldrich Pump LLC Case No. 20-30608 (JCW) should be consulted for all matters affecting this case.

5. Nothing contained in the Motion or this Order shall be deemed or

construed as directing or otherwise effectuating a substantive consolidation of any of the

above-captioned Chapter 11 Cases.

6. Pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule 9013-1(f), any party shall be entitled

to request that the Court reconsider entry of this Order by filing a motion for reconsideration

within 14 days of service of this Order.
