ORDER GRANTING COMPLEX CHAPTER 11 BANKRUPTCY CASE TREATMENT

These jointly administered cases were filed on November 8, 2023. A *Notice of Designation as Complex Chapter 11 Bankruptcy Case* was filed. Based on its review of the initial pleadings, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas (the “Court”) concludes that the complex case designation is appropriate. Accordingly, the Court orders:


1. The Procedures for Complex Cases in the Southern District of Texas apply to these cases. The procedures are posted on the Court’s website. Compliance with the procedures is required.
2. The Debtors must give notice of this Order to all parties in interest within seven days. If a party in interest objects to the provisions of this Order, that party may file an appropriate motion within 14 days after service of the Order.
3. The Bankruptcy Local Rules of the Southern District of Texas (the “Bankruptcy Local Rules”) apply to this case, subject to the following modifications:

¹ The Debtors in these chapter 11 cases, along with the last four digits of each Debtor’s federal tax identification number, are: Anagram Holdings, LLC (8535); Anagram International, Inc. (2523) and Anagram International Holdings, Inc. (5837). The location of the Debtors’ service address for purposes of these chapter 11 cases is: 7700 Anagram Drive, Eden Prairie, MN 55344. For the avoidance of doubt, the Debtors’ chapter 11 cases are not proposed to be consolidated with the Party City debtors which emerged from chapter 11 cases in this Court on October 12, 2023. *See In re Party City Holdco Inc., et. al.*, Case No. 23-90005 (MI). Any reference herein to the Debtors does not include the debtor-entities that were administered in the Party City chapter 11 cases.



- i. Bankruptcy Local Rule 1001-1(b) does not apply.
- ii. Local District Court Civil Rule 83.1 applies.
- iii. Appendix A to the Bankruptcy Local Rules of the District Court applies.
- iv. If a conflict exists between the Bankruptcy Local Rules and the Procedures for Complex Cases in the Southern District of Texas, the Procedures for Complex Cases in the Southern District of Texas govern.
