MOTION FOR ALLOWANCE OF AN 11 ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE CLAIM FOR BRUCE EPPS PURSUANT TO 12 CODE § 503(b)(1)(A) AND NOTICE 13 14 TO THE HONORABLE WHITMAN HOLT, THE OFFICE OF THE UNITED STATES 15 TRUSTEE, THE DEBTORS, AND COUNSEL TO THE DEBTORS: 16 In accordance with Bankruptcy Code § 503(b)(1)(A), Bruce Epps, moves the Court for an 17 order allowing him and administrative expense claim in the case for services he performed in his 18 capacity as director of plant services for the period of from the Petition Date through August 2, 19 2020, which is when his 30 day notice of termination will run. 20 This Motion is made pursuant to Bankruptcy Code (the "Code") § 503(b)(1)(A) as Mr. 21 Epps continued to work for the Debtor, Astria Regional Medical Center, in his capacity as 22 director of plant services at the Regional facility since the Petition Date. Mr. Epps gave 30 day 23 notice to the Debtor of his intent to terminate his employment on July 3, 2020, and will continue 24 to be working for the Debtor for the next 30 days thereafter. In support, Mr. Epps provides the 25 following in support: 26 27 In re Astria Health, Case No. 19-01189 28

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MOTION FOR ALLOWANCE OF AN ADMINISTRATIVE CLAIM

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- 1. Epps started working for Astria since November of 2017. He in fact returned to the Regional facility after two years away at the request of Rich Robinson, the CEO of Regional at that time. He has continued to be employed as direct of plant services at the Regional facility since that time, and has continued to be employed by the Debtor through its bankruptcy process.
- 2. Attached as Exhibit "1" to the Declaration of Bruce Epps filed in support of this motion (the "Epps Declaration") is an e-amil from Eric Davis, HR Director for Astria Health which sets out the Debtor's internal records related to "Priority Claim Hrs" and "Admin. Claim Hrs" for Mr. Epps. Debtor's records establish that Mr. Epps has accumulated 175.3756 in hours entitled to administrative claim treatment in the case.
- 3. Attached as Exhibit "2) to the Epps Declaration is a true and correct copy of his most recent paystub from Astria Health, which indicates that his current hourly rate is \$53.6746/hr.
- 4. Accordingly, based on time accrued and his current hourly rate, it would appear that Mr. Epps' administrative expense claim to date is \$9,413.22.
- 5. Mr. Epps assert that all time incurred which forms the basis of his administrative claim were actual and necessary cost for preserving significant assets of the bankruptcy estate – namely, the Regional facility and associate buildings and clinics in the Yakima area.
- 6. His job involved taking of all the boilers, air handlers, and all major equipment throughout the buildings, as was charged with responsibility for medical center, the medical office building, and other clinics in the Yakima area.
- 7. Mr. Epps right to his vacation pay accrued during the post-petition period of the Debtor's continued operations are just part of his overall compensation package, and having been earned by his continuing service during that time, should therefore be paid out as an administrative claim within the bankruptcy case.
- WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing, Mr. Epps respectfully requests that this Court enter an order:
  - Allowing Mr. Epps an administrative claim in the case in the amount of \$9,412.22; A.

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B.	Allowing an administrative claim for any additional accrued and earned vacation time
	during Mr. Epps final 30 days with the Debtor's, and;

C. Granting such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and appropriate under the facts and circumstances of these cases.
