**ORDER SHORTENING NOTICE AND SCHEDULING HEARING ON 9019 MOTION
AND RESCHEDULING THE SALE MOTION HEARING**

This matter is before the Court on the *Emergency Motion for (A) an Order Shortening Notice and Scheduling Expedited Hearing on Debtor’s Motion for Entry of an Order Authorizing and Approving Settlement and (B) Adjournment and Resetting of the Sale Hearing* (this “Motion”) of AstroTurf, LLC (the “Debtor”). All capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings given to them in the Motion.



The Court has considered the Motion, the 9019 Motion, and the other matters reflected in the record. It appears that the Court has jurisdiction over this proceeding; that this is a core proceeding; that notice of the Motion has been given to the parties listed on the Master Service List established in this case; that the relief sought in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtor, its estate, and its creditors; and that good and sufficient cause exists for such relief.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion (Doc. No. 150) is GRANTED.
2. A hearing will be held on the 11th day of August 2016 at 10:00 a.m. (EST) in Courtroom 1401, United States Courthouse, 75 Ted Turner Drive, SW, Atlanta, GA 30303 on the 9019 Motion. The hearing on the Sale Motion that is currently set for August 4, 2016, at 10:00 AM in Atlanta, Georgia is reset to the 11th day of August 2016 at 10:00 a.m. (EST) in Courtroom 1401, United States Courthouse, 75 Ted Turner Drive, SW, Atlanta, GA 30303.
3. The Debtor's claims and noticing agent is directed to serve copies of this order and the notice attached hereto as Exhibit 1 on the parties listed on the Master Service List established in this case. The Debtor's claims and noticing agent is directed to mail a copy of the notice attached hereto as Exhibit 1 on the Debtor's creditor matrix and any other parties that received notice of the Sale Motion.
4. The Debtor's claims and noticing agent shall file a certificate of service with the Clerk of the Court certifying the above-outlined service.
5. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from the implementation of this Order.

**NOTICE OF HEARING ON PROPOSED SETTLEMENT AND
CONTINUANCE OF SALE HEARING**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. On August 1, 2016, the Debtor filed its *Motion for Entry of an Order Authorizing and Approving Settlement Agreement* [Doc. No. 149] (the “9019 Motion”). A hearing on the 9019 Motion (the “9019 Hearing”) will be held in **Courtroom 1401, United States Courthouse, 75 Ted Turner Drive, SW, Atlanta, GA 30303 at 10:00 a.m. EST on August 11, 2016**. At the 9019 Hearing, the Debtor will seek authorization and approval of a settlement by and among the Debtor, the Committee and the Other Sellers (as those terms are defined in the 9019 Motion). **If the Court does not approve the settlement agreement as described in the 9019 Motion, the Debtor may seek approval of certain modifications to the settlement agreement at the 9019 Hearing.**

2. **Your rights may be affected by the court’s ruling on the 9019 Motion, including any modifications to the proposed settlement that may be sought at the 9019 Hearing.** You should read the 9019 Motion carefully and discuss it with your attorney, if you have one in this bankruptcy case. (If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to consult one.) If you do not want the court to approve and authorize the settlement agreement described in the 9019 Motion (or any modification thereof) or if you want the court to consider your views, then you and/or your attorney must attend the hearing. You may also file a written response to the pleading with the Clerk at the address stated below, but you are not required to do so. If you file a written response, you must attach a certificate stating when, how and on whom (including addresses) you served the response. Mail or deliver your response so that it is received by the Clerk at least two business days before the hearing. The address of the Clerk’s Office is Clerk, U.S. Bankruptcy Court, Suite 1340, 75 Ted Turner Drive, Atlanta Georgia 30303. You must also mail a copy of your response to the undersigned at the address stated below.

3. The hearing on the Debtor’s *Motion for Entry of an Order Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105, 363, and 365: (I) Authorizing the Sale of the Debtor’s Property Free and Clear of Liens, Claims and Encumbrances; (II) Authorizing the Assumption and Assignment of Contracts and Leases; and (III) Granting Related Relief* [Doc. No. 15] (the “Sale Motion”) scheduled for August 4, 2016, at 10:00 AM is reset to **August 11, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. EST in Courtroom**

1401, United States Courthouse, 75 Ted Turner Drive, SW, Atlanta, GA 30303. The conditions and limitations set forth in the *Notice of Proposed Sale of the Debtor's Assets, Proposed Assumption and Assignment of Executory Contracts and Leases, and Hearing* [Doc. No. 35] filed on June 30, 2016 remain applicable, including the requirement that objections, if any, to the Sale Motion, be filed with the Bankruptcy Court and served so as to be actually received by 5:00 p.m. local time in Atlanta, Georgia, on August 1, 2016.
