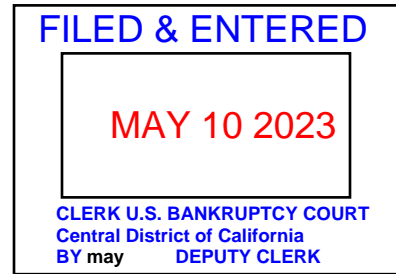

2 *Emergency Motion for Order (I) Approving Debtors' Use of Cash Collateral, and (II) Setting a*
3 *Final Hearing on the Use of Cash Collateral* [Docket No. 219] (the "Stipulation" relating to the
4 "Motion") and having jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1334; and having found
5 that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); that it may enter a final order
6 consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution; that venue of this proceeding and the
7 Motion in this district is permissible pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and good cause

9 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT


10 1. The Stipulation is approved as provided herein;

11 2. A final hearing on the Motion shall be held on May 17, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. Pacific
12 time. Any opposition to the Motion shall be filed and served on or before **12:00 p.m. noon Pacific**
13 **time on May 11, 2023**, and any reply in support of the Motion shall be filed and served on or before
14 **12:00 p.m. noon Pacific time on May 15, 2023**; and

15 3. This Court shall retain exclusive jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from
16 or related to the implementation, interpretation, and enforcement of the order approving this
17 stipulation.
