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Secured creditor and depository bank Hanmi Bank ("<u>Hanmi</u>") hereby submits its Joinder in (1) the *Master Trustee's Response to Debtors' Statement in Response to the Omnibus Objection to the Use of Cash Collateral and For Authority to Incur Post-Petition Financing* [Docket No. 343]; and (2) the *Objection to Debtors' Bidding Procedures* [Docket No. 337]filed by the Master Trustee (as defined therein) (collectively, the "May 26 Master Trustee Pleadings").

## **JOINDER**

Hanmi and its counsel have made every effort to avoid being swept up in the increasingly adversarial nature of the Debtors' cases. Indeed, Hanmi's counsel proposed the ongoing judicial mediation specifically in an attempt to address the distrust and communication breakdown between the parties.

However, Hanmi cannot ignore that it holds a secured claim of more than \$10 million that is entitled to the very rights and benefits that the Master Trustee has been diligently seeking to protect. And Hanmi wholeheartedly agrees that, regardless of any allocation of blame, the terms proposed by the Debtors for the use of cash collateral, DIP financing and bidding procedures suffer from the substantive problems outlined in the May 26 Master Trustee Pleadings.

Therefore, Hanmi files this Joinder (as it did on May 22 with respect to the Master Trustee's objection of the same date) in order to join in the objections and proposed modifications to the relief requested in the Debtors' underlying motions set forth in the May 26 Master Trustee Pleadings. In doing so, Hanmi does not seek to enflame the already volatile dynamics in these cases. To the contrary, Hanmi and its counsel will continue to work studiously to identify and facilitate opportunities for rapprochement and consensus through the ongoing judicial mediation and otherwise.
