INFORMATION CONCERNING COURT APPEARANCES

Parties may appear in person, by telephone or via video conferencing for the Briggs & Stratton hearing scheduled at **9:30 a.m. Central Time on Tuesday, September 15, 2020.**

Telephonic hearing requests must be submitted through CourtSolutions: <https://court-solutions.com>. A CourtSolutions account is required to request telephonic appearances and schedule hearing reservations. Parties must schedule hearing reservations by 12:00 p.m. Central Time on the business day prior to the date of the hearing. All Parties who do not anticipate speaking must select the Listen Only option.

During the hearing, all persons appearing telephonically must place their phone on mute except when speaking. Persons shall not place their phone on “hold” or use speakerphones. Persons who wish to speak must select the “Hand Raised” feature.

Parties may not speak unless directed by Judge Schermer. When speaking, please keep all background noise to a minimum so it does not interfere with the Judge and other parties being able to hear you.

If there is a problem connecting to the teleconference system, please disconnect your line and re-dial. If a connection cannot be made, please e-mail Ms. McCoy at Shontelle.McCoy@moeb.uscourts.gov promptly and we will work on resolving the issue.

Appearances by video will be through Cisco Webex. All persons appearing by video must turn their cameras off except when speaking. A separate Cisco Webex invitation will be sent to all parties who registered through CourtSolutions and to those who have contacted Ms. McCoy regarding the September 15, 2020, Briggs & Stratton hearing.

Parties proposing to admit evidence at the hearing shall provide two equal sets of paper copies in binders to the Court and email an electronic copy in PDF format to Judge.Schermer.Evidence@moeb.uscourts.gov no later than 3:00 p.m. Central Time the day prior to the hearing. All Exhibits must be clearly marked and indexed pursuant to this Court’s Local Rules.
