All Parties who do not anticipate speaking must select the "Listen Only" option.

During the hearing, all persons appearing telephonically must place their phone on mute when not speaking. Persons shall not place their phone on "hold" or use speakerphones. Persons who wish to speak must select the "Hand Raised" feature and may only speak when directed by Judge Schermer.
