**ORDER GRANTING EX PARTE APPLICATION FOR ORDER SHORTENING TIME
TO HEAR DEBTOR'S INITIAL EMERGENCY MOTIONS**

The Court having reviewed and considered the Ex Parte Application for Order Shortening Time (the "Application") to Hear Debtor's Initial Emergency Motions, which are: (1) Emergency Motion to Pay Certain Prepetition Compensation, Reimbursable Employee Expenses, and to Honor Vacation Pay and Sick Leave; (2) Emergency Motion to Approve Continued Use of Cash Collateral (Rents Associated with Real Property Located at 3110 W. 4 Bank Accounts; (iii) to Retain Agency Accounts; (iv); for Continued Use of Business Forms; and
5 (v) to Waive Compliance with Section 345(B); (5) Emergency Motion to Establish Noticing
6 Procedures and to Limit Notice; (6) Emergency Motion to Employ Kurtzman Carson Consultants,
7 LLC as Debtor's Claims and Noticing Agent; (7) Emergency Motion to Approve Assumption of
8 Critical Vendor Contracts; and (8) Emergency Motion to Approve Assumption of Insurance
9 Premium Finance Contracts (collectively, the "Initial Emergency Motions").

10 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Application is hereby GRANTED and the Debtor's
11 Initial Emergency Motions will be heard by a United States Bankruptcy Judge at the United States
12 Bankruptcy Court, 300 Las Vegas Blvd., Las Vegas, NV 89101 on November 05, 2018, at
13 10:30 a.m.


14 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that any opposition to the requested relief set forth in the
15 Initial Emergency Motions may be filed prior to the hearing or presented orally at the hearing.

16 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this hearing may be continued from time to time
17 without further notice expect for the announcement of any adjourned dates and time at the above-
18 noticed hearing or any adjournment thereof.
