INTERIM ORDER (I) AUTHORIZING THE DEBTORS TO (A) PAY PREPETITION WAGES, SALARIES, OTHER COMPENSATION, AND REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES AND (B) CONTINUE EMPLOYEE BENEFITS PROGRAMS, AND (II) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF

Upon the motion (the "Motion")² of the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "Debtors") for entry of an interim order (this "Interim Order") (a) authorizing the Debtors to (i) pay all prepetition and postpetition obligations on account of the Employee Compensation and Benefits in the ordinary course of business and (ii) continue to administer the Employee Compensation and Benefits, including payment of prepetition obligations related thereto, and (b) granting related relief, all as more fully set forth in the Motion; and upon the First Day Declaration; and this court having jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1334 and the Amended Standing Order; and this court having found that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and this court having found that it may enter a final order consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution; and this court having found that venue of this proceeding and the Motion in this district is proper pursuant to

The Debtors in these chapter 11 cases, along with the last four digits of each Debtor's federal tax identification number, are: Cobalt International Energy, Inc. 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and this court having found that the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors' estates, their creditors, and other parties in interest; and this court having found that the Debtors' notice of the Motion and opportunity for a hearing on the Motion were appropriate under the circumstances and no other notice need be provided; and this court having reviewed the Motion and having heard the statements in support of the relief requested therein at a hearing, if any, before this court (the "Hearing"); and this court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion and at the Hearing establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and upon all of the proceedings had before this court; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Motion is granted on an interim basis as set forth in this Interim Order.
- 3. The Debtors are authorized, but not directed, to pay, honor, and/or reimburse prepetition amounts outstanding under or related to the Employee Compensation and Benefits programs and the Non-Debtor Workers in the ordinary course of business and to pay any prepetition amounts due in connection therewith; *provided* that pending entry of a final order, the Debtors shall not honor any Employee Compensation and Benefits that exceed the priority amounts set forth in sections 507(a)(4) or 507(a)(5) of the Bankruptcy Code; *provided*, *further*, that pending entry of the final order, nothing herein shall be deemed to authorize the payment of any prepetition amounts on account of the Director Compensation, Severance Programs or the

Employee Incentive Programs, other than the Equity Taxes. For the avoidance of doubt, except as otherwise expressly set forth herein, nothing in this Interim Order should be construed as authorizing any payments on account of the Employee Compensation and Benefits that are outside the ordinary course of business without prior court approval.

- 4. Pursuant to section 362(d) of the Bankruptcy Code, Employees are authorized to proceed with their claims under the Workers' Compensation Program in the appropriate judicial or administrative forum and the Debtors are authorized to continue the Workers' Compensation Program and pay all prepetition amounts relating thereto in the ordinary course of business. This modification of the automatic stay pertains solely to claims under the Workers' Compensation Program.
- 5. Nothing herein shall be deemed to authorize the payment of any amounts which are subject to section 503(c) of the Bankruptcy Code.
- 6. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Motion or this Interim Order, any payment authorized to be made by the Debtors herein shall be subject to the terms and conditions contained in any orders entered by this Court authorizing the use of cash collateral (the "<u>Cash Collateral Orders</u>"). To the extent there is any conflict between this Interim Order and the Cash Collateral Orders, the terms of the Cash Collateral Orders shall control.
- 7. Notwithstanding the relief granted in this Interim Order and any actions taken pursuant to such relief, nothing in this Interim Order shall be deemed: (a) an admission as to the validity of any prepetition claim against a Debtor entity; (b) a waiver of the Debtors' right to dispute any prepetition claim on any grounds; (c) a promise or requirement to pay any prepetition claim; (d) an implication or admission that any particular claim is of a type specified or defined in this Interim Order or the Motion; (e) a request or authorization to assume any

prepetition agreement, contract, or lease pursuant to section 365 of the Bankruptcy Code; or (f) a

waiver of the Debtors' rights under the Bankruptcy Code or any other applicable law.

8. The banks and financial institutions on which checks were drawn or electronic

payment requests made in payment of the prepetition obligations approved herein are authorized

and directed to receive, process, honor, and pay all such checks and electronic payment requests

when presented for payment, and all such banks and financial institutions are authorized to rely

on the Debtors' designation of any particular check or electronic payment request as approved by

this Interim Order.

9. The Debtors are authorized to issue postpetition checks, or to effect postpetition

fund transfer requests, in replacement of any checks or fund transfer requests that are dishonored

as a consequence of these chapter 11 cases with respect to prepetition amounts owed in

connection with any Employee Compensation and Benefits.

10. The contents of the Motion satisfy the requirements of Bankruptcy Rule 6003(b).

11. Notice of the Motion as provided therein shall be deemed good and sufficient

notice of such Motion and the requirements of Bankruptcy Rule 6004(a) and the Bankruptcy

Local Rules are satisfied by such notice.

12. Notwithstanding Bankruptcy Rule 6004(h), the terms and conditions of this

Interim Order are immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

13. The Debtors are authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief

granted in this Interim Order in accordance with the Motion.

14. This court retains exclusive jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or

related to the implementation, interpretation, and enforcement of this Interim Order.
