ORDER AUTHORIZING THE OFFICIAL

COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS TO FILE UNDER SEAL THE (A) MOTION OF THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER (I) DENYING OR LIMITING THE CREDIT BID RIGHTS OF SSCP RESTAURANT INVESTORS LLC AND (II) HOLDING SALE FUNDS IN ESCROW PENDING DETERMINATION OF EXTENT, PRIORITY, AND VALIDITY OF SSCP'S SECURED CLAIM; AND (B) COMPLAINT AGAINST SSCP RESTAURANT INVESTORS LLC REDUCTION OF ITS CLAIM, DECLARATORY RELIEF, DISALLOWANCE OF ITS CLAIM, AND EQUITABLE SUBORDINATION

Upon consideration of the Motion for Entry of an Order Authorizing the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors to File Under Seal the (A) Motion of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors for Entry of an Order (I) Denying or Limiting the Credit Bid Rights of SSCP Restaurant

The Debtors in these chapter 11 cases, along with the last four digits of each Debtor's federal tax identification number, include CBC Restaurant Corp. 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Investors LLC and (II) Holding Sale Funds in Escrow Pending Determination of Extent, Priority, and Validity of SSCP's Secured Claim; and (B) Complaint Against SSCP Restaurant Investors LLC for Reduction of Its Claim, Declaratory Relief, Disallowance of Its Claim, and Equitable Subordination (the "Motion to Seal")² by the Committee pursuant to section 107 of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rule 9018, and Local Rule 9018-1; the Court finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter; due and proper notice of the Motion to Seal has been given, and no other or further notice is required; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion to Seal establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and it appearing that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and it appearing that the venue of this proceeding and this Motion to Seal is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and after due deliberation, and sufficient cause appearing therefor; it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

- 1. The Motion to Seal is **GRANTED** as set forth herein.
- 2. The Committee is authorized to file an unredacted copy of the Motion under seal and to file a redacted version of the same available for public viewing.
- 3. The Committee is authorized to file an unredacted copy of the Complaint under seal and to file a redacted version of the same available for public viewing.
- 4. Unredacted copies of the Motion and the Complaint shall not be made available to anyone except for this Court, the Debtors, SSCP, the U.S. Trustee, and others upon further order of the Court.

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² All capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Motion to Seal.

5. This Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
