<u>Status</u>: The parties have been in discussions with the PACA Creditors and have agreed upon modifications to the proposed order that address their concerns. The parties have also reached agreements in principle with the Landlords which they believe address the Landlord objections and concerns, subject to agreement on specific language in the bid procedures order. The parties have also been engaging in discussions with the US Trustee and the Committee and have reached agreement on many of the issues raised by their comments and objections and corresponding modifications to the form of bid procedures order. However, certain issues remain unresolved, particularly with respect to: (a) SSCP's role as a "consultation party," generally, and its entitlement to receive confidentiality agreements executed by other interested bidders in particular; and (b) whether "round skipping" will be permitted at the auction and whether any such rules will apply equally to SSCP and other bidders. This matter will be going forward.
