## STIPULATION WITHDRAWING DEBTOR'S OBJECTION TO **PROOF OF CLAIM NUMBER 3774** OF CLAIMANT NATHANIEL BRENT

Nathaniel Brent, the claimant ("Claimant"), and the City of Detroit, Michigan ("City"), hereby stipulate and agree as follows in support of the entry of the Order Withdrawing Debtor's Objection to Claim No. 3774, filed by the Claimant, attached hereto as Exhibit 1.

- 1. Claimant filed the Claim Number 3774, on June 3, 2014.
- Claim No. 3774 asserts a claim against the City in the amount of 2. \$5,000,000.00, and is based on alleged civil rights violations.
- 3. On February 22, 2011, the Claimant filed a lawsuit against multiple defendants, among them, the Detroit Police Department as well as two named and two unnamed police officers ("City Defendants"), in the United States District Court, Eastern District of Michigan ("District Court"), captioned Nathaniel Brent

and Robert Brent v. Mia Wenk, et al., Case No. 11-cv-10724 (the "District Court Case"), based upon the facts and circumstances asserted in Claim No. 3774.

- 4. The District Court Case was subsequently decided in favor of the City Defendants on November 9, 2016.
- 5. Claimant filed an appeal [Case No. 17-1428] with the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals ("Sixth Circuit Court") related to the District Court's judgment in favor of the City Defendants and on August 23, 2018, the Sixth Circuit Court affirmed the District Court's judgment in favor of the City Defendants.
- 6. Claimant filed a petition for rehearing en banc of the Sixth Circuit Court's decision. The petition was denied on October 11, 2018.
- 7. The City objected to Claim No. 3774 in the *Debtor's Sixty-Third Omnibus Objection to Certain Claims* [Doc. No. 12942] filed on November 13, 2018 (the "Objection"), based on the evidence that the litigation upon which the claim was based had been decided in favor of the City.
- 8. On January 15, 2019, Claimant filed his response to the City's Objection, which alleged that Claimant had filed a petition with the United States Supreme Court for review of the matter.
- 9. The City and the Claimant agree that Claim No. 3774 therefore remains the subject of unresolved litigation and the City's objection should therefore be withdrawn without prejudice.

WHEREFORE, the City and the Claimant respectfully request that the Court enter an order in the form attached as Exhibit 1 hereto.
