This matter having been raised to this Court by motion (the "Motion") of Allen D. Wilen, in his capacity as Liquidating Trustee and Estate Representative (the "Liquidating Trustee") for the bankruptcy estate of the captioned debtor, Bayonne Medical Center (the "Debtor"), by and through his counsel, Sills Cummis & Gross P.C., for the entry of an Order, pursuant to sections 105 and 502 of the United States Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101-1532 (the "Bankruptcy Code"), and Rules 3007 and 9006 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules"), extending the deadline by which the Liquidating Trustee must file objections to the allowance of claims against the Debtor or the Debtor's estate (the "Claims") by a period of approximately six (6) months through and including May 6, 2010, and extending all other deadlines affecting the Liquidating Trustee through and including May 6, 2010; and this Court having jurisdiction to consider the relief requested thereby under 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and this matter being a core proceeding under 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and this Court having considered the Motion, its supporting materials, and all responses thereto, if any; and after due deliberation thereon; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is hereby:

**ORDERED** that the deadline for the Liquidating Trustee to file objections to Claims is extended through and including May 6, 2010; and it is further

**ORDERED** that all ~~other~~ <sup>inconsistent with above decretal ¶</sup> deadlines in the Debtor's First Amended Joint Plan of Liquidation Under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code (the "Plan") and this Court's April 9, 2009, Order confirming the Plan (the "Confirmation Order") affecting the Liquidating Trustee are extended through and including May 6, 2010.
