OBJECTIONS TO MOTION OF DEBTORS FOR AN ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 105(a) AND 3633 OF
THE BANKRUPTCY CODE AUTHORIZING BUT NOT DIRECTING (I) WASHINGTON MUTUAL, INC. TO
EXERCISE ITS OWNERSHIP RIGHTS OVER CERTAIN TRUST ASSETS, (II) DISTRIBUTION OF TRUST ASSETS,
AND (III) TERMINATION OF THE TRUSTS

1. Said trusts, which are specified in Exhibit 'A' herein attached contain compensation duly earned by individuals while employed by WMI and its predecessor companies;
2. Said trusts were managed for the benefit of the employees that contributed to the trusts;
3. The trusts are solvent and were not responsible for the demise of WMI;
4. The management, officers and directors of WMI willfully, through fraud and negligence, wasted the assets of WMI, forcing WMI to seek protection in Chapter 11 Bankruptcy;
5. The safety of the Trusts were misrepresented to the participants, who were fraudulently induced to invest in said Trusts to their detriment;
6. The management, officers and directors of WMI knowingly engaged in business activities which enriched themselves personally at the expense of the employees, shareholders and creditors of WMI.

Now therefore, I pray that the Court Deny the motion of the Debtors to (I) Exercise its Ownership Rights Over Said Trusts, (II) Distribute the Trust Assets, and (III) Terminate the Trusts.
