Summary of Claims

Claimant was previously employed by Washington Mutual to the benefit of Washington Mutual, Inc. (Debtor) and through mutually beneficial agreements among Washington Mutual, a wholly owned subsidiary of Debtor and Claimant, all requirements by Claimant under those agreements including "Change in Control" and "Performance Bonus" have been satisfied by Claimant and the occurrence of eyents triggering earned and guaranteed payments to Claimant have occurred.

Claimant has calculated amounts due under the Change in Control agreement as a full payment net those sums received in severance payments. Claimant has calculated amounts due under the "Performance Bonus" prorated to the date of the Debtors bankruptcy filing.

Objection

Multiple cases and claims exist among Debtor, the FDIC and the acquiring institution of Washington Mutual as well as other third parties, some of which are claimants in the Debtor's bankruptcy as well as claimants with the FDIC.

It is believed by Claimant that independence among the Debtor, Washington Mutual and other subsidiaries of the Debtor have not been established and pending claims and cases may further provide additional facts regarding the relationship among the Debtor, Claimants and subsidiaries.

Although Claimant was an employee of Washington Mutual, the activities of the Claimant were to the benefit of the Debtor as well as the activities performed by claimant under the other subsidiaries of the Debtor.

Claimant requests that Debtors motion to disallow and expunge claims by Claimant be denied pending further findings regarding the relationship among the Debtor and subsidiaries and related concurrent cases.
