**ORDER SHORTENING THE TIME TO CONSIDER MOTION OF THE  
CONSORTIUM OF TRUST PREFERRED SECURITY HOLDERS TO  
COMPEL DEBTORS TO PRODUCE DOCUMENTS**

Upon the motion (the "Motion to Shorten") of the Consortium of Trust Preferred Security Holders ("TPS Consortium") for the entry of an order pursuant to Rules 9006-1(c) and 9006-1(e) of the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Practice and Procedure of the United States District Court for the District of Delaware, and § 105(a) of the United States Bankruptcy Code, shortening the notice period for the hearing on *Motion of the Consortium of Trust Preferred Security Holders to Compel Debtors to Produce Documents*, (the "Motion to Compel"); and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion to Shorten and the relief requested therein pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1157 and 334; and the Court having determined that the relief requested in the Motion to Shorten is appropriate; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion to Shorten is GRANTED;
2. The Motion to Compel shall be heard on May 19, 2010 at 11:30 am, and that
