Dear Judge Walrath


I hereby object to the voting process and irregularities involved within the voting in above cases .

My wife and I both bought shares of WAMPQ shares on Nov 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> of last week. within a matter of minutes I was contacted by SCHWAB and told I only had a limited time to vote those shares even though they were purchased past the record date of Oct 18<sup>th</sup>.

I would think that this alone should cast considerable doubts as to this vote count and just how accurate it may or may not be.

If I had voted or was going to be allowed to cast votes on shares obtained after the record date , it is of serious concern to me as to who else has done the same.

I have been informed that others have been given by different brokers , the same choices as I was to vote shares in fact bought after the required record date.
