**OBJECTION TO THE SUPPLEMENTAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENT FOR THE
MODIFIED SIXTH AMENDED JOINT PLAN OF AFFILIATED DEBTORS**

Dear Judge Walrath:

As a pre-seizure common shareholder of Washington Mutual, Inc., I am writing to object to the 'Supplemental Disclosure Statement for the Modified Sixth Amended Joint Plan of Affiliated Debtors'.

Upon information and belief, this Disclosure Statement fails to contain adequate information of a kind and in sufficient detail to enable hypothetical, reasonable investors typical of the Debtors' creditors to make an informed judgment whether to accept or reject the Plan. In fact, the Disclosure Statement appears carefully crafted to disclose nothing other than assets just below a level sufficient to cover creditor claims. For the record, I do not believe that the Debtors have identified all their assets; and I further believe that they have labored to minimize the effect of tax benefits (NOLs and any worthless stock deduction for WMI's \$26 billion in book value in WMB and WMB fsb) so as to portray assets as below liabilities to effect the disenfranchisement of shareholders.

In a case of this magnitude it is not credible, responsible, or equitable that the Debtors have valued all assets – including legal claims against the FDIC and JPMC – without relying upon the advice of legal counsel. Further, this Disclosure Statement is conspicuously devoid of anything even approaching a complete, audited list of assets (pre and post seizure) and their corresponding values or an audited valuation of the reorganized Debtors.

Accordingly, the Disclosure Statement falls far short of anything that might reasonable or legally be considered worthy of approval by the court, and I request that this court deny approval and admonish the Debtors to develop a new disclosure statement which complies with the law.
