- 2. Murphy is hereby granted leave to file an amended proof of claim asserting a claim pursuant to his WaMu severance plan as set forth in the Motion, within 15 days of the entry of this Order;
- 3. Murphy's amended proof of claim will relate back to the bar date established in these cases, March 31, 2009;
- 4. WMI Liquidating Trust may file an objection (the "Objection") to the amended proof of claim solely with respect to any WaMu severance plan claim amendment, unless otherwise agreed to by the parties or ordered by the Court, within 30 days of the entry of this Order;
- 5. Murphy may file a response, if any, to the Objection within 45 days of the entry of this Order;
- 6. The parties may take additional discovery solely with respect to the WaMu severance plan claim;
- 7. WMI Liquidating Trust is granted leave to bring an additional adversary proceeding related solely to the WaMu severance plan claim within 30 days of the entry of this Order;
- 8. Murphy hereby waives the invocation of any defense based on the running of any statute of limitation, statute of repose, period of prescription, contractual period of limitation, laches, and any other rule or doctrine, at law or in equity, relating to the timeliness of any claims that could have been timely asserted by WMI Liquidating Trust solely with respect to an adversary proceeding related to the WaMu severance plan claim.
- 9. This Order is without prejudice to the rights of any party to seek additional relief from this Court; and,

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10. This Court shall retain jurisdiction	with respect to any matters related to or arising from
the implementation of this Order.
