**STOUT EXCAVATING GROUP LLC'S NOTICE OF PERFECTION OF
STATUTORY LIEN PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 546(b)(2)**

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 546(b)(2), Stout Excavating Group LLC ("Stout"), by and through the undersigned counsel, hereby provides notice of perfection of its statutory lien. In support of this notice, Stout asserts as follows:

1. Stout is an excavating company which provided excavation and mining services to the sand mine located in Bexar County, Texas (the "Mine"), and owned by Superior Silica Sands, LLC ("Superior"). The amount due and owing Stout for such services as of July 15, 2019 (the "Petition Date") was at least \$3,274,933.93, exclusive of any accruing interest, costs, fees and other charges.

2. Pursuant to Texas Property Code § 56.001 *et seq.*, Stout holds a mining lien against the Mine and the land or related leasehold for which the labor or service was performed or furnished, the related buildings and appurtenances on the property, the material, machinery, and supplies furnished, supplied, or hauled by Stout, and other material, machinery, and supplies used for mineral activities and owned by Superior. The indebtedness for services accrues on the date the services were last furnished. *See* Texas Property Code § 56.005(b). A lien affidavit to preserve

the lien must be filed with the county clerk of the county in which the property is located not later than six months after the indebtedness accrues. *See* Texas Property Code § 56.021. The inception of the lien dates to the performance of the services. *See* Texas Property Code § 56.002. As such, Stout holds a lien on these assets in the amount of at least \$3,274,933.93, exclusive of any accruing interest, costs, fees and other charges.

3. In addition, while the lien does not affect an encumbrance that attached to the land or a leasehold before the lien's inception, the lien on material, machinery, supplies, or a specific improvement "takes priority over an earlier encumbrance on the land or leasehold on which the material, machinery, supplies or improvement is placed or located." *See* Texas Property Code § 56.004.

4. The Texas Property Code further requires that enforcement of the lien must occur within the same time or in the same manner as a mechanic's, contractor's, or materialman's lien under Chapter 53. *See* Texas Property Code § 56.041. In essence, this requires commencement of suit to foreclose the lien within two years of the last day a claimant may file the lien affidavit or within one year after completion, termination, or abandonment of the work under the original contract, whichever is later.

5. 11 U.S.C. § 546(b)(2) provides that where applicable law requires seizure of property or commencement of an action to accomplish perfection, or maintenance or continuation of perfection of an interest in property, the claimant may file a notice with the Bankruptcy Court in lieu of such seizure or commencement of suit.

6. Accordingly, in conformity with § 546(b)(2) Stout hereby provides notice to all parties in interest of its rights as a holder of a mining lien against Superior's assets as identified above. This notice is filed to preserve, perfect, and maintain Stout's rights in the assets which are

subject to its lien under Texas law, and to confirm with the requirements of the Texas Property Code and § 546(b)(2). This notice is intended to constitute the legal equivalent of filing a lien affidavit with the county clerk of the county in which the property is located and filing a foreclosure action. A copy of Stout's mining lien affidavit is attached as Exhibit A. Stout reserves all rights under 11 U.S.C. § 362(b)(3) but affirmatively asserts that all parties in interest are estopped from claiming that any filing was not commenced in a timely fashion under Texas law insofar as this notice was filed and served within the time required by the Texas Property Code and § 546(b)(2).

Owner contracted with Claimant to furnish materials, machinery, or supplies and/or perform labor and services on behalf of the owners of interests in the Subject Property.

Statutory Lien Claim

This Statement and Affidavit in Support of Lien on Mineral Property is filed pursuant to § 56.001, et seq. of the Tex. Prop. Code for the purpose of perfecting a lien upon one hundred percent (100%) of the working interest ownership in the Subject Property, including, but not limited to, the interests of the above-referenced owners in the Subject Property.
