FOUND AND DETERMINED THAT:

- A. Private-Network.com, Inc. ("Private Network") was properly and timely served with notice of the Fifth Omnibus Objection (Docket No. 467, Affidavit of Karen Wagner).
- B. Private Network failed to appear for a properly noticed deposition on December 21, 2009 (Docket No. 501, Notice to Take Depositions of Private-Network.com, Inc. and Affidavit of Service).
- C. Private Network failed to appear at the continued hearing on The 5th

 Omnibus Objection held January 7, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. at the United States Bankruptcy

 Court for the Southern District of New York (Docket No. 495, Order signed on 11/9/2009

 Expunging Duplicate Claims, Allowing Certain Claims and Adjourning Other Claims in

 Respect of Fifth Omnibus Objection and Granting Related Relief).
- D. The Fifth Omnibus Objection is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §157(b)(2).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- Reclassified Claims. Claim No. 2 of Private-Network.com, listed on
 Exhibit F of the Fifth Omnibus Objection, is hereby reclassified as a general unsecured claim.
- 2. Adjourned Hearing (the "Hearing") to be held. The Hearing on the Fifth Omnibus Objection as to Claim No. 408, Priority Claim of Mark McCarthy for \$8,739.80 filed July 21, 2008, is hereby adjourned to March 17, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. and shall be held at the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York in White Plains at 300 Quarropas Street, White Plains, NY 10601-4140. The Hearing shall be an evidentiary hearing to determine the value and treatment of claim no. 408.

3. The Claims Agent is hereby authorized and directed to make such

revisions to the official Claims Register as are necessary to reflect the relief granted

pursuant to this Order.

4. This Court shall retain jurisdiction over the claimants whose Claims are

subject to the Fifth Omnibus Objection with respect to any matters related to or arising

from the Fifth Omnibus Objection or the implementation of this Order.
