**ORDER SHORTENING NOTICE AND THE
TIME TO OBJECT WITH RESPECT TO DEBTOR' MOTION
FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER (I) APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT BY
AND AMONG THE DEBTORS AND DCP OPERATING COMPANY, LP,
(II) AUTHORIZING EXTRACTION OIL & GAS, INC. TO ASSUME THAT
CERTAIN GAS PURCHASE CONTRACT, AS AMENDED AND RESTATED,
WITH DCP OPERATING COMPANY, LP, AND (III) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF**

This matter having come before this Court on the *Debtors' Motion for Entry of an Order Shortening Notice and the Time to Object With Respect to Its Motion for Entry of an Order (I) Approving the Settlement by and among the Debtors and DCP Operating Company, LP, (II) Authorizing Extraction Oil & Gas, Inc. to Assume that Certain Gas Purchase Contract, as Amended and Restated, With DCP Operating Company, LP, and (III) Granting Related Relief* (the "Motion to Shorten"); this Court having reviewed the Motion to Shorten; this Court having jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and the Amended Standing Order of Reference, dated February 29, 2012; this Court having found this is a core proceeding under 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); this Court having found it may enter a final order consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution; this Court having found that venue of this

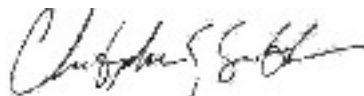

proceeding and the Motion to Shorten in this district is proper under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; this Court having found that the Debtors' notice of the Motion to Shorten and opportunity for a hearing on the Motion to Shorten were appropriate under the circumstances and no other notice need be provided; this Court having reviewed the Motion to Shorten and related materials; this Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion to Shorten and at the hearing establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Debtors' Motion to Shorten is GRANTED.
2. The *Debtors' Motion for Entry of an Order (I) Approving the Settlement by and among the Debtors and DCP Operating Company, LP, (II) Authorizing Extraction Oil & Gas, Inc. to Assume that Certain Gas Purchase Contract, as Amended and Restated, With DCP Operating Company, LP, and (III) Granting Related Relief* (the "9019 Motion") will be heard at a hearing on January 5, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. prevailing Eastern Time. Any objection or response to the 9019 Motion may be filed at the hearing.
3. The Debtors' shall file and serve a notice of hearing consistent with the terms of this Order.
