STATUS REPORT FOR OCTOBER 22, 2013 STATUS CONFERENCE

Brian A. Bash, Trustee herein, submits the following summary of the status of the Trustee's administration of the estate:¹

Recent Recoveries For the Estate

Since the last status conference in September 2013, the Trustee has recovered an additional \$178,467.22 for the estate. This amount includes \$110,000.00 received as part of an adversary proceeding settlement with Joan SerVaas and Bernard Durham, held in trust pending Court approval of the settlements, and \$34,446.97 received from Duvera Billing Services. As of October 18, 2013, the balance in the money market account maintained by the Trustee for the benefit of the Debtor's estate is \$6,533,948.63.

Motion to Amend the Procedures for the Assignment of Filed Claims

On October 1, 2013, the Trustee filed the *Trustee's Motion for an Order Amending the Procedures for the Assignment of Filed Claims.* The new procedure would require claim transferees to submit an Assignment Form executed by the transferor. The Trustee is requesting this amendment to the claims assignment procedures to ensure that evidence of the transferor's consent to the assignment of his or her claim is submitted to the Trustee's claims agent, Kurtzman Carson Consultants. The motion also asks the Court to waive the \$25 transfer fee recently imposed by amendments to the Bankruptcy Fee Schedule because, in this case,

administration of claims assignments is handled by the Trustee's claims agent instead of the clerk's office.

Motion to Compromise Controversy with Complete Discovery Source, Inc.

On October 14, 2013, the Trustee filed the *Motion of Trustee to Compromise Controversy with Complete Discovery Source, Inc.* Complete Discovery Source, Inc. ("CDS") is the company that provides the estate with document management-related services. Most notably, CDS manages the electronic data room, an online forum that houses the Debtor's records and the millions of pages of documents relevant to the more than 130 adversary proceedings filed by the Trustee. The data room has saved the estate hundreds of thousands of dollars of attorney review time and document production costs and has substantially reduced the likelihood of discovery disputes.

A disagreement has arisen between the Trustee and CDS related to payment for CDS' services through July 31, 2013. This Court's order approving the creation of the data room and the agreement between the Trustee and CDS both cap the Trustee's payment obligations for CDS' services, unless CDS obtains prior written consent from the Trustee to exceed that cap. The Trustee asserts that he has complied with the terms and conditions of this Court's order and the parties' agreement, that CDS never requested or obtained consent from the Trustee to exceed that cap, and that there is no balance due and owing from the estate to CDS through July 31, 2013.

CDS asserts that the data assumptions provided by the Trustee and relied upon by CDS were substantially incorrect, the costs associated with running the data room have exceeded the caps set by the Court's order and the parties' agreement, and the Trustee owes CDS a total of \$232,982.00 through July 31, 2013, over and above the cap set by the data room agreement and Court order. This dispute is described in more detail in the Trustee's compromise motion.

Although the Trustee continues to assert that the Court's order and the parties' agreement preclude CDS from invoicing the estate for the disputed amounts and denies any liability to CDS, the Trustee has agreed to settle the dispute by making a payment to CDS in the amount of \$92,500. In reaching this compromise, the Trustee considered the cost to the estate of defending a claim by CDS, the distraction created by litigation against the estate and corresponding depletion of resources from the Trustee's administration of the estate and pursuit of other adversary proceedings, and the benefit to the estate of obtaining a settlement at this state of the litigation without further uncertainty and expense.

The Trustee's Collection Efforts on Judgments

1. Creditor's Bill Actions

The Trustee filed a Creditor's Bill action to attach the interests of Timothy Durham and James Cochran in an insurance policy with National Union. Durham and Cochran have filed answers to the Creditor's Bill, and National Union has filed a motion to dismiss the Creditor's Bill. The Trustee filed a response and an amended response to National Union's motion to dismiss, and the Court addressed outstanding issues in this case at a pre-trial held on October 2, 2013. Following the pre-trial, National Union filed a proposed order under which National Union would deposit the insurance proceeds with the Court. The Trustee filed a motion requesting minor substantive changes to the proposed order, and the matter remains pending with the Court.

On August 5, 2013, National Union filed a *Complaint* seeking to interplead the insurance proceeds with this Court. The Trustee and defendants Snow, Schaffter, Head, Durham, Cochran, and Laikin have filed answers; Laikin also filed a counterclaim for a declaratory judgment that he is entitled to payment of his defense costs. National Union filed a motion to dismiss Laikin's counterclaim. On October 10, 2013, the Court issued an order permitting National Union to

interplead with the Court the insurance proceeds at issue, minus the amount owed to the mediator in this matter. The total amount of proceeds interpleaded with the Court is \$989,344.25.

2. Domestication of Judgments

The total amount of default judgments obtained by the Trustee and approved by the District Court is \$334,788,021.16, inclusive of \$286,421,487.42 in Group A default judgments and \$48,366,533.74 in Group B default judgments. A spreadsheet identifying the adversary proceeding number, judgment debtor(s), default judgment date, amount and summary of collection strategy for each judgment is attached as **Exhibit A** to this status update.

The Trustee has targeted twelve judgments for domestication. Each judgment has been domesticated in at least one jurisdiction, and several judgments – such as those against Mr. Durham and Durham Capital Corporation – have been domesticated in multiple jurisdictions. To date, the Trustee has domesticated judgments in at least 20 jurisdictions.

The Trustee is focusing his collection efforts on the judgment debtors with the eight largest outstanding judgments. The total amount of these judgments is \$184,127,060.53. As indicated in prior status reports, the Trustee issued document subpoenas to all known banks for the six largest corporate judgment debtors to assist his evaluation of claims. While the Trustee has previously indicated that he plans to pursue bank garnishments against these judgment debtors, he is re-evaluating that plan in light of cost-benefit concerns arising from information received in response to the subpoenas. In addition, the Trustee has obtained possession of 10,892,646 shares of stock owned by Durham and/or other judgment debtors, and he intends to commence appropriate proceedings to execute and realize upon those securities.

Based on information received, the Trustee believes there may be viable claims to bring against account debtors of the default judgment defendants. The Trustee is investigating to determine the viability of the claims and their likely benefit to the Estate. The investigation is initially focusing on the largest of the default judgments, but may broaden to encompass smaller judgments.

The Trustee has obtained one default judgment against individuals who are believed to be British nationals. The total amount of this judgment is \$205,997.77. Given the size of the judgment and the foreign site of assets, the Trustee has determined that an evaluation of collectability issues on this matter is not a priority item at this time.

Finally, the Trustee is domesticating in Indiana the final judgment obtained in the adversary proceeding against Stephen Plopper and Associates (Northern District of Ohio, Case Number 5:13-cv-00678) in the amount of \$128,792.68, plus interest at 18% from January 1, 2010, and \$6,649.63, plus interest. The Trustee is in discussions with Stephen Plopper regarding payment on that judgment.

Subsequent Transferee Litigation

To date, the Trustee has filed two subsequent transferee adversary proceedings seeking a total of \$1,442,872.57. Additional subsequent transferee cases may be brought in the future after further review of the bank documents and an analysis of the potential subsequent transferee defendant's ability to repay the transfers. The pending subsequent transferee litigation includes the following matters:

- 1. Litigation against Vitesse Corporation and Vitesse II, LLC (approximately \$1,275,872.57); and
- 2. Litigation against Old National Bank (approximately \$167,000.00).

The Trustee is proceeding to seek default judgment in the *Vitesse* litigation and is reviewing discovery responses recently served by the defendant in the *Old National Bank* litigation.

Status of Litigation

The chart attached as **Exhibit B** includes a list of all pending litigation as of October 16, 2013, including those cases that have been settled or otherwise resolved by the Trustee, with information on the corresponding settlement amount or resolution. Additional descriptions are provided below.

Fortress Credit Corp. The parties attended mediation on October 1 and 2, 2013. The Fortress litigation was not resolved at that mediation. The parties have exchanged initial expert reports and recently identified rebuttal experts. The parties are to exchange rebuttal expert reports by November 12, 2013. Motions for Summary Judgment are due by October 29, 2013, with Briefs in Opposition due by December 3, 2013, and Reply Briefs due by December 17, 2013.

The Remaining "Group A" Cases:

The following are the other active and pending Group A cases:

- 1. Litigation against the former legal advisor for Fair Finance, Ronald Kaffen (approximately \$180,000);
- 2. Litigation against John Head, a former officer of the Debtor (approximately \$2.5 million in claims);
- 3. Litigation against Ricky Snow, a former officer of the Debtor (approximately \$1.7 million in claims).

The discovery in the litigation against Ronald Kaffen and his law firm is being coordinated with the discovery taking place in the Fortress litigation, but fact discovery specific to the Kaffen case has been completed.

The discovery in the litigation against John Head and Ricky Snow is also being coordinated with the discovery taking place in the Fortress litigation. In the litigation against Ricky Snow, the Trustee and counsel for Mr. Snow have agreed to settlement terms and documentation, which is pending signature by the incarcerated Mr. Snow and will be presented to the Court for approval. It is the Trustee's understanding that the receipt of settlement documents has been hampered by counsel's involvement in other pending litigation and the

difficulty of communicating with an incarcerated defendant.

"Group B" Cases:

The one hundred and twenty-seven (127) cases in the "Group B" category of cases include claims based on non-debtor transfers, loans or preferential transfers for which actions were filed after November 2011. These cases include the following:

- 1. **Fraudulent Transfer or Contract Claims:** This group of cases includes one hundred and six (106) lawsuits. Of those lawsuits, five (5) remain active and contested and an additional six (6) cases have been stayed, generally because of the defendant's bankruptcy. The Trustee has settled or otherwise resolved his claims in fifty-three (53) lawsuits. In addition, a number of defendants in these lawsuits have defaulted, including all of the defendants in forty-three (43) lawsuits and some of the defendants in six (6) lawsuits. The Trustee has obtained default judgments in most of these cases.
- 2. Section 547 Claims Against Investors: The Trustee filed twelve (12) preference complaints against investors. All of these complaints have been settled or otherwise resolved.
- 3. Section 547 Claims Against Non-Investors: The Trustee filed seven (7) complaints against non-investors receiving preferential payments from the Debtor. All of these complaints have been settled or otherwise resolved.

The chart attached as Exhibit B includes a list of all of the Group B cases status as of

October 16, 2013, including those cases that have been settled or otherwise resolved by the Trustee with information regarding the corresponding settlement amount or other resolution. The Trustee is pursuing settlement of the remaining Group B cases and will continue to prepare those matters for trial, if necessary.

Other Litigation: The Trustee is pursuing recovery for the estate in several other lawsuits involving certain state-law claims, including loan claims and claims against certain insiders of the Debtor. This group of cases includes the only lawsuit filed by the Trustee outside of this district (the *National Lampoon* litigation filed in the United States District Court for the Central District of California, Western Division). These cases include the following:

- 1. The Laikin litigation (approximately \$33 million). A bench trial took place in this matter before this Court during a period from September 16-26, 2013.² This court has not yet issued a report and recommendation regarding that bench trial. Defendant Laikin filed a *Motion for Leave to Appeal* this Court's pre-trial sanctions order with the District Court, which the Trustee opposed. On September 23, 2013, the District Court denied defendant Laikin's *Motion for Leave to Appeal* the sanctions order.
- 2. National Lampoon (approximately \$9 million). The Trustee has received access to a significant volume of discovery material which was in the possession of National Lampoon. Discovery is ongoing. The Trustee and counsel for National Lampoon are currently in discussions regarding National Lampoon's claims of confidentiality and privilege and the sufficiency of National Lampoon's discovery responses. The parties are in the process of scheduling fact witness depositions in that matter. The District Court has set trial in this matter for June 3, 2014.
- 3. The *McKibben* litigation against insiders of the Debtor and entities they controlled. On August 30, 2013, National Union Fire Insurance Co. moved to withdraw its *Motion to Permit Advancement of Certain Defense Costs*. Defendants Cochran and Durham objected.

On August 15, 2013, Defendants Laikin, Head, Schaffter, Snow, Cochran and Durham moved the District Court to withdraw the reference in this matter. This motion was granted. The McKibben litigation is now pending in the Northern District of Ohio, case number 5:13-cv-02098-DCN. Dispositive motions are to be filed by October 21, 2013.

As previously described, National Union, filed an action to interplead insurance policy proceeds related to this case. The policy proceeds have been deposited with this Court. A proposed order granting the interpleader and dismissing National Union has been filed with the Court and circulated among the parties. The Trustee filed a response to the proposed order suggesting two minor changes relating to the Trustee's rights to a portion of the proceeds acquired by the Trustee through the filing of his Creditor's Bill action against National Union, Durham and Cochran.

Trustee's Focus in the Upcoming Weeks

Continuing Litigation: The Trustee's counsel will continue to focus efforts on the

litigation of the cases that have been filed by the Trustee to date.
