Selfridge in Michigan, near home but still farther from the war. Nalle continued his training literally until the war ended on Aug. 15, 1945.

There was a moment where he thought he might join combat — on July 1, 1945. But, Burgess said, the pilots were held up again. Then a pilot dropped an atomic bomb on Hiroshima and, three days later, Nagasaki.

Russell Nalle had missed the war.

"They kept being held up by the kinds of things a segregationist commander can do - not allow training, force to repeat training," Burgess said.
"The overriding thing was the United States Army Air Force did not want any blacks flying at all. They didn't want them to succeed.'

Nalle re-enlisted because he had agreed upon entry to stay for 20 years. But after atomic bombings, the U.S. armed forces were drastically reduced in number. Nalle said he didn't have enough seniority to stay.

When he had been stationed at Godman Army Air Field near Ft. Knox years before, he met his wife, Louise, now deceased. So, when he left the

service, he worked as a photographer for a while, but eventually returned home, to his Detroit. He worked for Ford, which had granted him a leave of absence in 1939. But he worked for Ford only a few weeks before he began looking for a job as a pilot.

"They had no openings," Nalle said. "That was their story.'

They became teachers, like Lt. Col. Alexander Jefferson, a Tuskegee Airman who was a POW during the war; Lt. Col. Harry Stewart, among the first winners of the Top Gun award in 1949, became an engineer. Nalle became a real estate agent, but the money was no good, he said.

So he did what he'd learned to do in the war: He fixed

"We went into the home improvement business, repairing houses, building rec rooms, making bedrooms out of attics," he said. He had come full circle,

and being inducted into the Tuskegee Airmen officially last week, meant he'd come full circle there, too.
