## NOTICE OF DISCLOSURE STATEMENT HEARING

- 1. On October 1, 2013, Groeb Farms, Inc. (the "**Debtor**") filed the *Disclosure Statement for the Debtor's Plan of Reorganization Pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code* (as may be amended, modified or supplemented, the "**Disclosure Statement**") [Docket No. 23] with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Michigan (the "**Bankruptcy Court**"). The Debtor submitted the Disclosure Statement pursuant to section 1125 of the Bankruptcy Code for use in the solicitation of votes on the *Debtor's Plan of Reorganization Pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code* (as may be amended, modified or supplemented, including the Plan Supplement and all other exhibits and schedules, the "**Plan**"), a copy of which was filed with the Bankruptcy Court on October 1, 2013, as an exhibit to the Disclosure Statement. The Debtor may file an amended Plan and Disclosure Statement prior to the Disclosure Statement Hearing (as defined below) and reserves the right to amend, supplement, or modify such documents further. Capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Plan or Disclosure Statement, as the context so requires.
- 2. A hearing currently is scheduled before the Honorable Walter Shapero, United States Bankruptcy Judge for the Eastern District of Michigan, on November 21, 2013 at 1:30 p.m. (the "Disclosure Statement Hearing") at the United States Courthouse, Courtroom 1042, 231 West Lafayette Street, Detroit, MI 48226 to consider the entry of an order approving, among other things, (a) the Disclosure Statement as containing "adequate information" pursuant to section 1125 of the Bankruptcy Code; (b) procedures for soliciting, receiving and tabulating votes on the Plan and for filing objections to the Plan; (c) the form of ballots, notices, and certain other documents to be distributed in connection with the solicitation of the Plan; (d) the deadlines contained in the solicitation and confirmation procedures; and (e) the procedures for notice of the confirmation hearing and filing objections to confirmation of the Plan.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT THE DISCLOSURE STATEMENT HEARING MAY BE CONTINUED FROM TIME TO TIME BY THE COURT OR THE DEBTOR WITHOUT FURTHER NOTICE OTHER THAN BY SUCH ADJOURNMENT BEING ANNOUNCED IN OPEN COURT OR BY A NOTICE OF ADJOURNMENT FILED WITH THE COURT. IF THE DISCLOSURE STATEMENT HEARING IS MOVED TO NOVEMBER 7, 2013, THE DEBTOR WILL SEND TO YOU AN ADDITIONAL NOTICE.
