Exhibit A

Advisors Equity Group, LLC ("<u>Claimant</u>") is a newly formed start-up joint venture that is owned by NexPoint Insurance Distributors, LLC ("<u>NID</u>") and third parties. NID is a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Debtor. NID has an ownership interest in and revenue share rights with respect to Claimant. Claimant and NID also entered into a multi-draw promissory note pursuant to which NID agreed to fund up to \$1.5 million to Claimant. Despite this commitment, however, no funds have been advanced by NID to date. Accordingly, Claimant may have a claim against the Debtor. Claimant has requested information from the Debtor to ascertain the exact amount of its claim. This process is on-going. Additionally, this process has been delayed due to the outbreak of the Coronavirus. Claimant is continuing to work to ascertain the exact amount of its claim and will update its claim in the next ninety days.
