

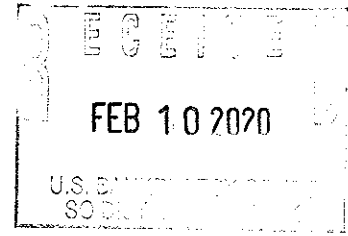

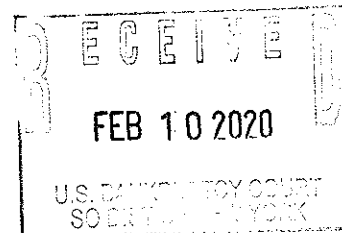

I have waited months for MoviePass Inc to do the right thing and honor their statement and refund customers with no action. I submitted a claim thru the Better Business Bureau, however once MoviePass filed for bankruptcy this past week I was informed to file this claim for repayment after liquidation of the company takes place. I realize it is a long shot and I am one of many with this problem, but I purchased a service which continued to modify its deliver. From a movie a day, to a chosen movie occasionally, to a chosen movie sometimes at certain times, to rarely. I got two months of use out of the program, not at full usage but I am willing to take a prorated refund of the two months I was able to see films occasionally. I feel I am owed \$99.50 for the ten months of no service.

I paid \$119.40 on April 22, 2019. Service was stopped on July 3, 2019 with no warning and never returned for me.
