**ORDER GRANTING PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF THE
DISCLOSURE STATEMENT**

The Debtor has filed a combined plan and disclosure statement. The court has reviewed the disclosure statement and has decided to grant it preliminary approval. Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the disclosure statement is granted preliminary approval, subject to any timely and proper objections.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Debtor, through its Official Claims, Balloting and its Noticing Agent, Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC (“KCC”), shall, in accordance with L.B.R. 3018-1(a) (E.D.M.), within seven (7) days of entry of this Order arrange for service of solicitation packages in the following approved formats: first-class mail, electronic service, and/or U.S.B. thumb drive.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for that purpose KCC shall use the most updated copy of the case creditor matrix, and the Debtor, through its counsel,



Dykema Gossett, LLC, shall file with the Court as promptly as possible a Certificate of Service which shall set forth to whom notice has been given.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Voting Record Date for voting purposes is the date on which the Debtor filed its combined plan and disclosure statement.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline to return ballots on the plan, as well as to file objections to final approval of the disclosure statement and objections to confirmation of the plan, is **November 26, 2021, at 4:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time)**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Debtor, through KCC, is permitted to receive ballots from those creditors entitled to vote on the plan via mail and via electronic submission through a secure portal on KCC's website maintained for this chapter 11 case at <http://www.kccllc.net/HFV>. Completed ballots may be returned via mail to KCC at Henry Ford Village, Inc. c/o Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC, 222 N. Pacific Coast Highway, Suite 300, El Segundo, California 90245.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for the Debtor, through KCC, to file its tabulation declaration and/or verified summary of ballot count is **December 3, 2021**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the telephonic hearing on objections to final approval of the disclosure statement and confirmation of the plan shall be held

on **December 6, 2021, at 11:00 a.m. (prevailing Eastern time)**, before the Honorable Mark A. Randon. At least five minutes before the scheduled time for hearing, counsel and parties should call 1-888-363-4734 and use Access Code 2795304. Please place phone on mute and wait until your case is called. Once case is called, unmute phone and participate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for all professionals to file final fee applications is no later than 30 days after the Effective Date of the Plan.
