**OBJECTION OF AJL MANUFACTURING, INC. AND ARNPRIOR RAPID
SOLUTIONS, INC. TO DEBTORS' MOTION FOR AN ORDER
ESTABLISHING AND IMPLIMENTING EXCLUSIVE PROCEDURES
FOR TREATMENT OF RECLAMATION CLAIMS**

AJL Manufacturing, Inc. and Arnprior Rapid Solutions, Inc. ("Reclamation Creditors") hereby submit the following objection to the Debtors' Motion for an Order Establishing and Implementing Exclusive Procedures for Treatment of Reclamation Claims ("the Motion"), and respectfully represent as follows:

1. The time to make a demand for reclamation of goods under Bankruptcy Code §546(c) has expired. The Reclamation Creditors have each made demands in compliance with §546(c) prior to the expiration of the period set by statute for the making of such demands.

2. The Motion received by counsel for the reclamation creditors on February 7, 2012 and will not be heard until February 15, 2012. Both dates are beyond the period for making a reclamation demand under §546(c).




3. The Motion seeks to retroactively impose procedures for the making of a reclamation demand that are beyond those contained in the statute. Since the period for reclamation demands has expired, the Reclamation Creditors could not possibly comply with those non-statutory procedures.

4. To the extent that any of the procedures requested in the Motion would impose obligations on Reclamation Creditors that are not contained in §546(c) of the Bankruptcy Code, the Motion must be denied.

WHEREFORE, Reclamation Creditors respectfully request that the Court deny the Motion to the extent that it seeks to impose obligations upon Reclamation Creditors that are not contained in §546(c) of the Bankruptcy Code. Reclamation Creditors further request such additional relief as is proper.
