Dear Judge Gropper,

This letter is written on behalf of eight individuals, listed below, that completed employment with Kodak in December 2011 (with one individual extended until 1/6/12) prior to Kodak’s filing for bankruptcy for Chapter 11 bankruptcy on January 19, 2012. Previously, you received a letter from Verlyn J. Belisle, an individual within the ZERO KURIP Group. This letter is filed with the court as Docket 3687. Those noted on this memo are in support of Mr. Belisle’s summary and request(s). While we have no issue with the request for a committee as described in Dockets 3645 and 3645(2), we know with certainty that our situation is different from the majority of the class of individuals covered by these Dockets. In our situation, we are a small group of former Kodak employees who have received ZERO of their earned KURIP retirement benefit payments that range in value for each person from \$100,000 to \$800,000.

Your Honor has also received a request for a committee as noted in Dockets 3645 and 3645 (2) – Motion Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. 1102 (a)(2) For Appointment Of A Committee To Represent Holders of KERIP and KURIP claims. The majority if not all of the individuals noted in Dockets 3645 and 3645(2) have received annuities for a period of time (as they ended employment with Kodak at earlier date(s)). The individuals noted in Docket 3645 and 3645(2) are concerned with the claim amount and/or the calculation used by Kodak to determine the claim and/or the form and method used by Kodak to allow a claim to be filed. This is not the situation for the ZERO KURIP Group. We are in agreement with Kodak on the claim amount and have filed these claims with the court. While KERIP and KURIP payments to those listed in Dockets 3645 and 3645(2) ceased after the Chapter 11 petition, for those in the ZERO KURIP Group, the payments were committed but never paid with an effective date of January 1, 2012.

We respectfully request that if a Committee is formed as requested in Dockets 3645 and 3645(2) that it is important that those individuals noted within the ZERO KURIP Group be duly represented by someone from the ZERO KURIP Group on the Committee. At this time, there is NO reference to the ZERO KURIP Group of individuals and our uniquely shared situation within Dockets 3645 and 3645(2). We would appreciate your consideration of both the Committee and the appointment of Mr. Verlyn J. Belisle to the Committee on behalf of the ZERO KURIP Group: Verlyn Belisle, Cathy Brill, Robert Fischmann, Nancy Plews, Judy Pribe, Laurel Spring, Neil Tornes, and Nicoletta Zongrone.

Thank you for your consideration of our input and we appreciate you supporting our request for representation for the ZERO KURIP Group on any Committee that is serving the interests of those with lost KURIP and KERIP retirement benefits.
