Gropper, United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York, One Bowling Green, New York, New York 10004 and (b) the Debtors and their counsel, so as to be actually received no later than **December 11, 2013 at 4:00 p.m. (Eastern Time)**.

- (c) a concise statement setting forth the reasons why the Disputed Claim should not be disallowed or modified for the reasons set forth in the Objection, including, but not

limited to, the specific factual and legal bases upon which the Respondent will rely in opposing the Objection;

(e) the address(es) to which the Debtors must return any reply to the Response; and

(f) the name, address and telephone number of the person (which may be the claimant or its legal representative) possessing ultimate authority to reconcile, settle or otherwise resolve the Disputed Claim and/or the Response on behalf of the Respondent.

Eastman Kodak Company (“**Kodak**”), on behalf of itself and its affiliated debtors  
in these chapter 11 cases (each, a “**Debtor**,” and collectively, the “**Debtors**”), in accordance with

the *Order Authorizing and Approving Omnibus Procedures for Filing Claim Objections* [Docket No. 1972] (the “**Omnibus Objection Procedures Order**”), hereby submits this omnibus objection (this “**Objection**”) to each of the claims (collectively, the “**Disputed Claims**”) listed on Exhibit A to the proposed form of order (the “**Proposed Order**”) attached hereto as Exhibit 1, and requests the entry of the Proposed Order disallowing and expunging, in full, each of the Disputed Claims, as indicated in further detail below and on Exhibit A to the Proposed Order. In support of this Objection, the Debtors respectfully represent and set forth as follows:

### **Background**

1. On January 19, 2012 (the “**Petition Date**”), each of the Debtors filed a voluntary petition in this Court for relief under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101 *et seq.* (the “**Bankruptcy Code**”). On January 25, 2012, the United States Trustee for the Southern District of New York (the “**U.S. Trustee**”) appointed the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the “**Creditors Committee**”) pursuant to section 1102 of the Bankruptcy Code.

2. On June 26, 2013, the Court entered an order [Docket No. 4167] approving the Debtors’ *First Amended Disclosure Statement for Debtors’ First Amended Joint Plan of Reorganization Under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code* [Docket No. 4143], and on August 23, 2013, the Court entered an order [Docket No. 4966] (the “**Confirmation Order**”) confirming the *First Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization of Eastman Kodak Company and Its Debtor Affiliates* (as may be amended, modified or supplemented, including the plan supplement and all other exhibits and schedules, the “**Plan**,” a copy of which is attached to the Confirmation Order as Exhibit A thereto).<sup>3</sup> The Effective Date of the Plan occurred at 12:01

a.m. (Eastern Time) on September 3, 2013 [see Docket No. 5015].

**Facts Specific to the Relief Requested**

**A. The General Bar Date Order**

3. On January 19, 2012, the Court entered an order [Docket No. 47] appointing Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC (“**KCC**”) as the claims and noticing agent in these chapter 11 cases. Among other things, KCC is authorized to (a) receive, maintain, and record and otherwise administer the proofs of claim filed in these chapter 11 cases and (b) maintain official claims registers for reach of the Debtors.

4. On May 10, 2012, the Court entered an order [Docket No. 1159] (the “**General Bar Date Order**”) (a) providing that, except as otherwise provided therein, all persons and entities (including, without limitation, individuals, partnerships, corporations, joint ventures, trusts and governmental units as defined by section 101(27) of the Bankruptcy Code) that assert a claim, as defined in section 101(5) of the Bankruptcy Code, against the Debtors that arose prior to the Petition Date shall file a proof of such claim in writing so that it is received on or before July 17, 2012 at 5:00 p.m. (Prevailing Eastern Time) (the “**General Bar Date**”), and (b) approving the form and manner of notice of the General Bar Date.<sup>4</sup>

5. The Bar Date Order also provides that:

any person or entity that holds an equity security interest in any of the Debtors need not file proofs of interest with respect to the ownership of such equity interest [(collectively, “**Proofs of Interest**”)]; provided, however, that if any such holder asserts a claim against the Debtors (including a claim relating to an equity interest or the purchase or sale of such equity interest), a [p]roof of [c]laim must be filed on or prior to the [General] Bar Date pursuant to the procedures set forth in [the] [General Bar Date] Order.

6. Additionally, pursuant to the General Bar Date Order, any person or entity that holds a claim (each, a “**Rejection Damages Claim**”) that arises from the rejection of an executory contract or unexpired lease, as to which the order authorizing such rejection is dated on or before the date of entry of the General Bar Date Order, must file a proof of claim based on such rejection on or before the General Bar Date, and any person or entity that holds a Rejection Damages Claim, as to which an order authorizing such rejection is dated after the date of entry of the General Bar Date Order, must file a proof of claim by the later of (a) the General Bar Date, or (b) 30 days following the entry of the order approving such rejection, or be forever barred from doing so.<sup>5</sup>

7. The General Bar Date Order also provides that if the Debtors amend or supplement the Schedules subsequent to the date of entry of the General Bar Date Order or determine, in their business judgment, to require any non-Debtor subsidiaries of the Debtors having a claim against any of the Debtors to file a proof of claim, then the Debtors shall give notice of any amendment or supplement to the holders of claims affected thereby, and such holders shall be afforded 30 days from the date of such notice to file proofs of claim in respect of their claims or be barred from doing so, and shall be given notice of such deadline and the related proof of claim filing requirements.

#### **B. The Administrative Claim Bar Date Order**

8. On September 5, 2013, the Court entered an order [Docket No. 5028] (the “**Administrative Claim Bar Date Order**”) (a) providing that, except as provided therein, all persons and entities (including, without limitation, individuals, partnerships, corporations, joint

ventures, trusts and governmental units as defined by section 101(27) of the Bankruptcy Code) that assert a General Administrative Claim against the Debtors shall file a request for payment of such General Administrative Claim (each a “**Request for Payment**” and, collectively, the “**Requests for Payment**”) so that it is received on or before October 18, 2013 at 5:00 p.m. (Prevailing Eastern Time) (the “**Administrative Claim Bar Date**”), and (b) approving the form and manner of notice of the Administrative Claim Bar Date.

9. In accordance with the Administrative Claim Bar Date Order, the Administrative Claim Bar Date Notice (as defined therein) was served by first-class mail at least 35 days prior to the Administrative Claim Bar Date on: (a) the U.S. Trustee; (b) counsel for the Creditors’ Committee; (c) all persons or entities that have requested notice of the proceedings in these chapter 11 cases pursuant to rule 2002 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the “**Bankruptcy Rules**”); (d) all persons or entities that have filed claims against the Debtors; (e) all known creditors and other known holders of claims as of the date of entry of the Administrative Claim Bar Date Order; (f) all parties to executory contracts and unexpired leases of the Debtors; (g) the attorneys of record to all parties to pending litigation against any of the Debtors; (h) U.S. Bank, National Association and Wilmington Trust, National Association, as indenture trustees; (i) Davis Polk & Wardwell LLP, counsel to Citicorp North America, Inc., as agent for the Debtors’ postpetition secured lenders; (j) Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld LLP, counsel to the Ad Hoc Committee of Second Lien Noteholders; (k) the Internal Revenue Service, the Securities and Exchange Commission, the United States Attorney’s Office for the Southern District of New York, and all applicable government entities; and (l) all other parties in the Debtors’ creditor matrix not included in the foregoing (the “**Notice Parties**”).

10. Following the entry of the Administrative Claim Bar Date Order and service to the Notice of Parties of the Administrative Claim Bar Date Notice, prior to the Administrative Claim Bar Date, KCC received over 350 Requests for Payment.<sup>6</sup>

**C. Omnibus Objection Procedures Order**

11. On September 4, 2012, the Court entered the Omnibus Objection Procedures Order, approving certain procedures for filing omnibus claims objections, including, without limitation, authorizing the Debtors and any other party in interest to file omnibus claims objections seeking reduction, reclassification and/or disallowance of claims on certain grounds identified therein, in addition to the grounds set forth in Bankruptcy Rule 3007.

**Jurisdiction**

12. The Court has jurisdiction to consider this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334. Venue is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409. This matter is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b). The statutory predicates for the relief requested herein are sections 502(b), 503(b) and 507(a) of the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rules 3003 and 3007.

**Relief Requested**

13. By this Objection, the Debtors request entry of the Proposed Order, disallowing and expunging, in full, each of the Disputed Claims, as indicated in further detail below and on Exhibit A to the Proposed Order.<sup>7</sup>

14. In accordance with the Omnibus Objection Procedures Order and Bankruptcy Rule 3007(e), this Objection addresses not more than 100 Disputed Claims.

**Basis for Relief**

15. In addition to the reasons for expunging and disallowing the Disputed Claims set forth in the section below, none of the Disputed Claims qualifies for administrative expense priority pursuant to section 503(b) of the Bankruptcy Code. Section 503(b)(1)(A) of the Bankruptcy Code provides that only “actual, necessary costs and expenses of preserving the estate” are allowed as administrative expenses. 11 U.S.C. § 503(b)(1)(A). A party asserting an administrative expense claim has the burden of proving that such expense was actual and necessary for preserving the estate. *See In re Old Carco LLC*, 424 B.R. 650, 657 (Bankr. S.D.N.Y. 2010); *In re Drexel Burnham Lambert Group Inc.*, 134 B.R. 482, 489 (Bankr. S.D.N.Y. 1991). Courts in this District have held that section 503(b)(1)(A) should be narrowly construed due to “the bankruptcy goal of providing equal distribution of a debtor’s assets to all creditors.” *Old Carco*, 424 B.R. at 656 (internal quotation omitted); *see also Drexel Burnham*, 134 B.R. at 488.

16. Specifically, “an expense is administrative only if it arises out of a transaction between the creditor and the bankrupt's trustee or debtor in possession, . . . and only to the extent that the consideration supporting the claimant’s right to payment was both supplied to and beneficial to the debtor-in-possession in the operation of the business.” *Trustees of Amalgamated Ins. Fund v. McFarlin’s, Inc.*, 789 F.2d 98, 101 (2d Cir. 1986) (internal quotations and citations omitted). No claimant asserting a Disputed Claim has carried the burden of showing that the expense related to its Disputed Claim was necessary for the Debtors’ postpetition operations or the preservation of the Debtors’ estates. As such, the Disputed Claims

are not entitled to administrative expense priority pursuant to section 503(b)(1)(A) of the Bankruptcy Code.

**A. Equity Interest Claims**

17. The Disputed Claims identified in the row titled “*Claim To Be Expunged*” on Exhibit A to the Proposed Order (collectively, the “**Equity Interest Claims**”) assert the ownership of an equity security interest in one of the Debtors, and not a claim against the Debtors. Therefore, in reality, the Equity Interest Claims are merely Proofs of Interest which neither the Administrative Claim Bar Date Order, nor the General Bar Date Order, require to be filed in these chapter 11 cases. Among other reasons, the Debtors were able to identify the Equity Interest Claims as being Proofs of Interest because the claimants noted on their relevant Requests for Payment that the Equity Interest Claims were filed on account of an equity security interest in one of the Debtors and/or they attached a brokerage statement demonstrating such ownership. Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 3007(d), a debtor may object to claims and seek their disallowance where such claims “are interests, rather than claims.” Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3007(d)(7). Any failure to disallow the Equity Interest Claims will result in the applicable claimants receiving an unwarranted recovery against the Debtors’ estates, to the detriment of creditors in these chapter 11 cases.

18. Accordingly, the Debtors object to the Equity Interest Claims and request entry of the Proposed Order disallowing and expunging, in full, each of the Equity Interest Claims.

**Responses to this Objection**

19. Any responses to this Objection must be filed **on or before 4:00 p.m. (Eastern Time) on December 11, 2013**, in accordance with the procedures set forth in the notice of this Objection.

**Reservation of Rights**

20. The Debtors and their estates reserve any and all rights to amend, supplement or otherwise modify this Objection, the Proposed Order, or Exhibit A thereto and to file additional objections to any and all claims filed in these chapter 11 cases, including, without limitation, any and all of the Disputed Claims. The Debtors and their estates also reserve any and all rights, claims and defenses with respect to any and all of the Disputed Claims, and nothing included in or omitted from this Objection, the Proposed Order, or Exhibit A thereto is intended or shall be deemed to impair, prejudice, waive or otherwise affect any rights, claims, or defenses of the Debtors and their estates with respect to the Disputed Claims.

**Notice**

21. Notice of this Objection has been provided to: (a) the U.S. Trustee; (b) claimants whose Disputed Claims are subject to this Objection; and (c) all parties requesting notice in these chapter 11 cases pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2002. The Debtors respectfully submit that further notice of this Objection is neither required nor necessary.

**No Prior Request**

22. The Debtors have not previously sought the relief requested herein from this or any other court.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth herein, the Debtors respectfully request that the Court (a) enter the Proposed Order, and (b) grant such other and further relief as may be just and proper.

Any and all rights, claims and defenses of the Debtors and their estates with respect to any and all of the Disputed Claims shall be reserved, and nothing included in or omitted from the Objection is intended or shall be deemed to impair, prejudice, waive or otherwise affect any rights, claims, or defenses of the Debtors and their estates with respect to the Disputed Claims.

5. The requirements set forth in rule 9013-1(b) of the Local Rules for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York are satisfied.

6. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and to determine all matters arising from or related to implementation of this Order.
