OHIO CLASS COUNSEL'S MOTION FOR AN AWARD OF ATTORNEYS' FEES AND PAYMENT OF EXPENSES IN CONNECTION WITH THE OHIO SECURITIES <u>LITIGATION SETTLEMENT</u>

Labaton Keller Sucharow LLP ("**Ohio Class Counsel**"), on behalf of itself and other Plaintiffs' counsel, hereby respectfully moves for an Order, pursuant to Rule 23(h) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, made applicable hereto, for settlement purposes only, by Bankruptcy Rule 7023: (a) awarding attorneys' fees in the amount of 30% of the Ohio Securities Litigation Settlement Fund; (b) awarding litigation expenses in the amount of \$1,288,866.60, to be paid from the Ohio Securities Litigation Settlement Fund; (c) approving Class Representative's request for payment of his costs and expenses related to his representation of the Ohio Settlement Class in the amount of \$15,000, pursuant to the Private Securities Litigation Reform Act of 1995 ("PSLRA"), 15 U.S.C. § 78u-4(a)(4), to be paid from the Ohio Securities Litigation Settlement Fund; and (d) for such other and further relief as this Court deems just and proper.
