**NOTICE OF (I) ENTRY OF CONFIRMATION ORDER,  
(II) OCCURRENCE OF EFFECTIVE DATE, AND (III) RELATED BAR DATES**

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**TO CREDITORS, EQUITY HOLDERS, AND OTHER PARTIES IN INTEREST:**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that on July 26, 2017, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the “Court”) confirmed the *Debtors’ and Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors’ Joint Plan of Liquidation Pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code*, as modified, supplemented and amended [Docket No. 1266] (the “Plan”) and attached as **Exhibit A** to the *Order Confirming the Debtors’ and Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors’ Joint Plan of Liquidation Pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code (With Technical Amendments)* [Docket No. 1352] (the “Confirmation Order”).<sup>2</sup>

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that the Effective Date, as defined in the Plan, occurred on **August 22, 2017**. The release, excuplation, and injunction provisions of the Plan are now in full force and effect.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that on the Effective Date, except for any executory contracts or unexpired leases: (i) that previously were assumed; (ii) previously rejected by an order of the Bankruptcy Court, pursuant to section 365 of the Bankruptcy Code (the “Previously Rejected Leases and Contacts”); (iii) that constitute contracts of insurance in favor of, or that benefit, the Debtors or the Estates; or (iv) that were previously sold, conveyed or otherwise assigned pursuant to Final Order, each executory contract and unexpired lease entered into by the Debtors prior to the Petition Date that has not previously expired or terminated pursuant to its own terms shall be deemed rejected pursuant to section 365 of the Bankruptcy Code. Solely with respect to any executory contract or unexpired lease rejected pursuant to the Plan and the Confirmation Order, any and all claims arising from any such rejection must be filed on or before **September 21, 2017**. Nothing in the Plan or the Confirmation Order shall be

deemed to extend the applicable Bar Date for any claims arising from Previously Rejected Leases and Contracts.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that, except as otherwise provided by the Confirmation Order, the Plan, or any Order of the Court, requests for payment of all Administrative Expenses, other than those for which a Bar Date was previously set (including the Bar Dates set by the Bar Date Orders) or for which a request and/or proof of Claim has previously been filed, must be Filed and served on the Liquidation Trustee and the United States Trustee by no later than **September 21, 2017**. Any Administrative Expense subject to a prior Bar Date and not filed (including the Bar Dates set the Bar Date Orders) shall be considered Disputed Claims and not Timely Filed.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that, pursuant to the Plan, the deadline to file final requests for payment of Professional Fee Claims is **October 6, 2017** (the “Professional Fee Application Deadline”). All professionals must file final requests for payment of Professional Fee Claims by no later than the Professional Fee Application Deadline to receive final approval of the fees and expenses incurred in these Chapter 11 Cases.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that pursuant to Article XVI.A of the Plan, Confirmation will bind the Debtors, all Holders of Claims, Administrative Expenses, or Interests, and other parties in interest to the provisions of the Plan whether or not the Claim, Administrative Expense, or Interest of such Holder is Impaired under the Plan and whether or not the Holder of such Claim, Administrative Expense, or Interest has accepted the Plan.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that copies of the Plan, the Confirmation Order, and other related documents also may be obtained (a) free of charge upon request to Kurtzman Carson & Consultants LLC (the notice and claims agent retained in these chapter 11 cases) by calling 1-866-967-0499; (b) by visiting the website maintained in these chapter 11 cases at <http://www.kccllc.net/malibu> or (c) for a fee via PACER by visiting <http://www.deb.uscourts.gov>. Any parties in interest who (i) wish to receive notices of filings and certain pleadings after the Effective Date under Bankruptcy Rule 2002; and (ii) who have not already filed a request to receive such notice, may file such request with the Court.
