PROCEEDINGS

THE COURT: Good morning, everybody. Are the parties ready to proceed?

MR. DURRER: Good morning, Your Honor.

THE COURT: Are you ready to proceed with the McClatchy matter, Mr. Durrer?

MR. DURRER: Yes, Your Honor. Van Durrer, Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom, on behalf of the debtors. Thank you, Your Honor, again.

I'm looking at docket 457, which is the agenda for today's hearing, the amended agenda. There are four matters that should go very quickly. I believe that Your Honor's already signed the orders on matters 1 and 2.

Matter 3 was the debtors' motion to extend our exclusive periods. As noted, we were able to reach an agreement with the UCC, which is reflected in docket number 456, which contemplates a consensual extension of plan exclusivity, the filing exclusivity through August 30. That takes us a full month, approximately, past our contemplated sale process, should accommodate a plan process if we pivot in that direction, but obviously we'll see as things develop and might make further adjustments in collaboration with the committee.

And to be clear, all rights are reserved. If they want to try and accelerate a shortening of exclusivity, they have

that right, and that's confirmed in the form of order as well. 1 So I don't know if Your Honor wants further 2 3 explanation of that. I think it's pretty routine, but we would request Your Honor enter that order. 4 THE COURT: It looked fine to me. Is there anybody on 5 6 the phone who objects? 7 All right. Just submit that and we'll enter it. 8 That's fine. MR. DURRER: Thank you, Your Honor. And then number 9 10 4, we're just keeping tabs on this. We had hoped to present a consensual order today on that, Your Honor. We're not quite 11 12 there, but we are very close. Mr. Howard had asked us for an 13 update on that. We provided that as of yesterday. 14 Worst case scenario, we'll push it to the June 24 15 omnibus hearing, but I actually anticipate that we'll be able 16 to submit a consensual order to Your Honor in advance of the 17 Memorial Day holiday. 18 THE COURT: Okay. What's the sticking? Are you able to say? 19 20 MR. DURRER: I think it's just language. I think it 21 would be -- I think we would invite many more comments if I 22 went into details that would not be constructive for purposes of today, so I think we just call it a win, and this can be a 23
