<u>VERIFIED MOTION TO SET ASIDE ORDER ENTERED APRIL 29, 2021 AS TO THE</u> <u>SUPPORTED UNLIQUIDATED CLAIM INVOLVING HERNANDO SANDOVAL -</u> <u>CLAIM # 2047- ONLY</u>

The Movant, Hernando Sandoval, files this Motion to Set Aside Order entered April 29, 2021 regarding the supported unliquidated claim involving Hernando Sandoval – Claim# 2047, and states as follows:

1. On April 29, 2021, an Order was entered by the Honorable Michael Wiles, U.S. Bankruptcy Judge, Granting the Plan Administration Trustee's Thirty Sixth Omnibus Objection to Claims thereby disallowing and expunging certain Unliquidated Claims. A copy of the Order is attached and marked as Exhibit "A".

2. The movant, and supported unliquidated claim holder, Hernando Sandoval, has an active civil claim in the Circuit Court of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit in and for Miami-Dade County, Florida (case number 14-020039-CA-01) against Defendant/Debtor, Miami Herald Media Company.

3. The undersigned, on behalf of Hernando Sandoval, was notified on April 29, 2021, for the very first time, of the U.S. Bankruptcy Courts Order, by way of Defendant/Debtor, Miami Herald Media Co's, filing the U.S. Bankruptcy Order into the Miami-Dade Circuit Court Docket as a



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Notice of Filing the Notice of Denial of Plaintiff's Claim in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court. A copy of Defendants Notice of Filing is attached and marked as Exhibit "B".

4. Prior to entry of the Order on April 29, 2021 and receipt of same through the Circuit Court docket, the undersigned did not receive Notice of the Trustee's Thirty-Sixth Omnibus Objections to Claims. Additionally, the undersigned did not receive notice of the Hearing to be held on April 28, 2021 regarding the Objections to Claims. The only reason the undersigned received the U. S. Bankruptcy Court Order was the filing of the Order by Defendant Miami Herald Media Company into the Court Record in the Circuit Court; however, the same Defendant DID NOT file the Notice of Objections nor the Notice of Hearing into the Circuit Court docket, nor did the undersigned receive notice from the Bankruptcy Court of the Objections or the Hearing.

5. On April 30, 2021, the undersigned immediately reached out to counsel of record in the Bankruptcy proceeding to address the lack of notice and due process issues, including the potential of an agreed Order to set aside the specific claim involving Hernando Sandoval. However, during June of 2021, the communications fell apart. See attached emails marked as composite Exhibit "C".

6. Initially, we were advised that the parties to the Bankruptcy action would likely have no problem setting aside the discharge of Mr. Sandoval's claim – once discussions between the various parties took place. However, in June, 2021 we learned that the parties either could not, or would not agree, and requested we file a pleading into the Bankruptcy Record to request the Order discharging Ms. Sandoval's claim be vacated.

7. We do not believe there is an objection to the allegation(s).

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8. For these reasons, we respectfully request the Order discharging Mr. Sandoval's claim be vacated – as to Sandoval, and allow his right to a claim proceed.

WHEREFORE the movant and supported unliquidated claim holder, Hernando Sandoval, respectfully move this Honorable Court to Enter an Order granting the Movant's Motion to Set Aside the Supported Unliquidated Claim of Hernando Sandoval from the Order entered April 29, 2021 disallowing and expunging the claim in its entirety as to claim #2047, only.

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appearing that no other or further notice is necessary; and it appearing that the relief requested in the Objection is in the best interests of the Debtors, their estates, their creditors, and other parties in interest; and that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Objection establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and a Certificate of No Objection concerning the Objection having been filed on April 23, 2021; and upon the hearing conducted before this Court on April 28, 2021 to consider the Objection (the "**Hearing**") and upon the record of the Hearing; and after due deliberation thereon; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor; it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

1. The relief requested in the Objection is GRANTED as set forth herein.

2. The Unliquidated Claims listed on **Exhibit 1** and **Exhibit 2** annexed hereto are hereby disallowed and expunged in their entirety.

3. Each claim and the objections by the Plan Administration Trustee to each claim as identified and set forth on **Exhibit 1** and **Exhibit 2** annexed hereto constitutes a separate contested matter as contemplated by Bankruptcy Rule 9014. This Order shall be deemed a separate order with respect to each claim. Any stay of this Order shall apply only to the contested matter that involves such creditor and its claim and shall not act to stay the applicability or finality of this Order with respect to the other contested matters and corresponding claims.

4. The Plan Administration Trustee shall have the right to further object in the future on any ground to any of the Unliquidated Claims that are not disallowed and expunged pursuant to this Order, including to seek disallowance and expungement of same, and the rights and defenses of the claimants regarding such claims are fully preserved. Neither the Objection nor this

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Order shall constitute any admission or finding with respect to the validity or amount of the Unliquidated Claims that are not disallowed and expunged pursuant to this Order.

5. The claims agent retained in the Debtors' Chapter 11 Cases is authorized to reflect the disallowance and expungement of the Unliquidated Claims on the official claims register maintained for the Debtors' cases.

6. The terms and conditions of this Order are effective immediately upon

entry.

7. This Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation or interpretation of this Order.
