We are aware that the bidding process in the case of Neighbors Legacy Holdings et.al. has recently concluded with the dollar winner appearing to be a break-up of the company to multiple bidders, I am concerned for the welfare of the physician and non-physician employees. The physician and non-physician employees are best served by retaining the enterprise intact as a whole entity. Unless there is a substantial financial gain in the break-up bid process (optional to put a number in here like the \$2.5million), then the insecurity and inefficiency provided by the break up bid is not worth the sacrifice. We are also learning that some of the winning bidders are planning to shut down current operating centers which will end up costing jobs to lots of employees and physicians.
