**DECLARATION OF
SYDNEY REITZEL REGARDING
THE SOLICITATION AND TABULATION OF VOTES
ON THE JOINT PREPACKAGED PLAN OF REORGANIZATION
OF OSG HOLDINGS, INC. AND CERTAIN OF ITS DEBTOR AFFILIATES**

I, Sydney Reitzel, depose and say under the penalty of perjury:

1. I am a Director of Corporate Restructuring Services employed by Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC (“KCC”), located at 222 North Pacific Coast Highway, Suite 300, El Segundo, California 90245. I am over the age of 18 and not a party to this action.

2. I submit this declaration with respect to the solicitation of votes and the tabulation of ballots cast on the *Joint Prepackaged Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization of OSG Holdings, Inc. and Certain of its Debtor Affiliates Pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code*

[Docket No. 21] (as modified, amended, or supplemented from time to time, the “Plan”).² Except as otherwise noted, all facts set forth herein are based on my personal knowledge, knowledge that I acquired from individuals under my supervision, and/or my review of the relevant documents. I am authorized to submit this declaration on behalf of KCC. If I were called to testify, I could and would testify competently as to the facts set forth herein.

3. Prior to the commencement of these chapter 11 cases, OSG Holdings, Inc. and its affiliated debtors and debtors in possession engaged KCC as their notice, claims, and solicitation agent (the “Solicitation Agent”) to assist with, among other things, (a) service of solicitation materials to the parties entitled to vote to accept or reject the Plan and (b) tabulation of votes cast with respect thereto. KCC and its employees have considerable experience in soliciting and tabulating votes to accept or reject proposed prepackaged chapter 11 plans.

4. On October 15, 2023 the Debtors filed the *Debtors' Emergency Ex Parte Application for Entry of an Order Authorizing the Employment and Retention of Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC as Claims, Noticing, and Solicitation Agent* [Docket No. 10], and the Bankruptcy Court entered an order approving the retention on October 16, 2023 [Docket No. 30].

I. Service and Transmittal of Solicitation Packages and Related Materials

5. KCC distributed the solicitation and non-voting packages pursuant to the Solicitation Procedures described in the *Debtors' Emergency Motion for Entry of an Order (I) Scheduling a Combined Disclosure Statement Approval and Plan Confirmation Hearing, (II) Conditionally Approving the Disclosure Statement, (III) Establishing a Plan and Disclosure Statement Objection Deadline and Related Procedures, (IV) Approving the Solicitation Procedures, (V) Approving the Combined Notice, (VI) Conditionally Waiving the Requirement that*

the U.S. Trustee Convene a Meeting of Creditors and the Debtors File (A) Schedules and SOFAs and (B) Rule 2015.3 Financial Reports, and (VII) Granting Related Relief [Docket No. 20] (the “Motion”), which were approved by the Bankruptcy Court in the *Order (I) Scheduling a Combined Disclosure Statement Approval and Plan Confirmation Hearing, (II) Conditionally Approving the Disclosure Statement, (III) Establishing a Plan and Disclosure Statement Objection Deadline and Related Procedures, (IV) Approving the Solicitation Procedures, (V) Approving the Combined Notice, (VI) Conditionally Waiving the Requirement that the U.S. Trustee Convene a Meeting of Creditors and the Debtors File (A) Schedules and SOFAs and (B) Rule 2015.3 Financial Reports, and (VII) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 53] (the “Order”).

6. The Debtors established October 10, 2023 as the Voting Record Date for determining the Holders of Claims in Class 3 (Existing First Lien Claims) and Class 6 (Other General Unsecured Claims) (collectively, the “Voting Classes”) entitled to vote to accept or reject the Plan. No other Classes were entitled to vote on the Plan.

A. Prepetition Solicitation

7. On October 13, 2023, KCC caused the Solicitation Packages to be served via electronic mail and first-class mail to Holders of Claims in Class 3 and Class 6 entitled to vote on the Plan. Furthermore, KCC caused the Rights Offering Package³ to be served on Holders of Claims in Class 3 via electronic mail.

8. A certificate of service evidencing the prepetition service of the foregoing was filed with the Bankruptcy Court at Docket No. 46.

B. Postpetition Solicitation

9. Furthermore, on October 18, 2023, KCC caused the Combined Hearing Notice to be served on the current and former employees included in the creditor matrix. The Notice of Non - Voting Status, including the Opt-Out Form, and Combined Hearing Notice were served on the remainder of the creditor matrix, including Holders of Claims not entitled to vote in Class 1 (Other Secured Claims), Class 2 (Other Priority Claims), Class 4 (General Unsecured Trade Claims), Class 5 (General Unsecured Litigation Claims), Class 7 (Intercompany Claims), Class 8 (Existing Interests), and Class 9 (Intercompany Interests).

10. A certificate of service evidencing the postpetition service of the foregoing was filed with the Bankruptcy Court at Docket No. 128.

11. During the voting and opt out period, KCC forwarded materials to parties whose packages were returned with a forwarding address. A supplemental certificate of service evidencing the foregoing was filed with the Bankruptcy Court at Docket No. 142.

12. On October 23, 2023, the Publication Notice was published in *The New York Times (National Edition)* and on October 24, 2023 in *Chicago Tribune*. An affidavit evidencing the foregoing was filed at Docket No. 107.

II. The Tabulation Process

13. KCC worked closely with the Debtors' counsel and financial advisors to create a voting database reflecting the names and addresses of Holders of Claims and Interests, the classification of Claims and Interests, and voting amounts for the Voting Classes. KCC relied on information provided by the lenders' administrative agent pertaining to the Holders of Claims in Class 3.

14. In accordance with the Solicitation and Voting Procedures, KCC reviewed, determined the validity of, and tabulated the Ballots submitted to Vote on the Plan. Each Ballot

submitted to KCC was date-stamped, scanned, assigned a Ballot number, entered into KCC's voting database, and processed. To be included in the tabulation results as valid, a Ballot must have been (a) properly completed pursuant to the Solicitation and Voting Procedures, (b) executed by the relevant Holder entitled to vote on the Solicited Plan (or such Holder's representative), (c) returned to KCC via an approved method of delivery set forth in the Solicitation Procedures unless the delivery method requirement was waived by the Debtors, and (d) received by KCC on or before the Voting Deadline (*i.e.*, November 13, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. prevailing Central Time) or the Opt-Out Deadline (*i.e.*, November 15, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. prevailing Central Time), as applicable, established by the Order.

15. The final tabulation of votes cast by timely and properly completed ballots received by KCC were compiled and tabulated on November 16, 2023, and is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**. The detailed Ballot report for Class 3 is attached hereto as **Exhibit A-1**. The Ballot for Class 6 was not returned.

III. Ballots That Were Not Counted

16. A report of the Ballots excluded from the final tabulation is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**. These Ballots did not satisfy the requirements for a valid ballot as set forth in the Solicitation Procedures.

IV. Opt-Out Election

17. KCC reviewed and documented which Holders of Claims or Interests elected to opt out of the Third-Party Release either by (i) checking the Opt-Out box on a returned Ballot, or (ii) returning the Opt-Out Form attached to the Non-Voting Notice. A report of all Holders who elected to opt out of the Third-Party Release is attached hereto as **Exhibit C**. For the avoidance of doubt, this Declaration does not certify the validity or enforceability of any opt-out elections

received, including those reported on **Exhibit C**, but rather is providing these opt-out election results for reporting and informational purposes only.

V. Conclusion

18. To the best of my knowledge, information, and belief, I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing information concerning the distribution, submission, and tabulation of ballots in connection with the Plan is true and correct.
