Re: *In re Paragon Offshore, plc* – Motion to Vacate the Partial Sanctions Order

Dear Judge Sontchi:

I write to bring the Court’s attention to a typo that appears in the Motion to Vacate the Partial Sanctions Order filed on October 1, 2021 (“**Motion**”).

Paragraph 17, line four of the Motion reads as follows: “expiration of the “safe harbor”) and entered the Partial Sanctions Order on January 11.” This is wrong. The Court did not enter the Partial Sanctions Order (as defined in the Motion) until January 30, 2018.

Line four of paragraph 17 was intended to refer to the Court’s Order denying the Motion to Revoke (as defined in the Motion), which was entered on January 11, 2018. *See Paragon I*, Docket Entry No. 2047.

The point being that, the Court rejected the Motion to Revoke at the hearing on January 10, 2018 and entered the order memorializing that rejection on January 11, 2018.
