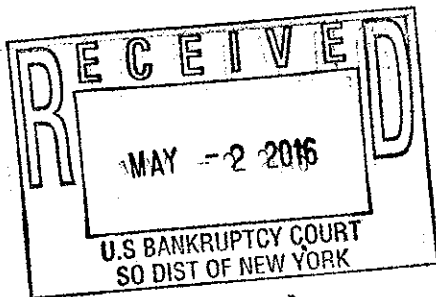
1. I am the duly authorized custodian or other qualified witness of business records of Hawk, Fulwider and Associates, Inc., and have authority to make this certification.
