I, Heather Fellows, depose and say:

1. I am employed by Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC (“**KCC**”), the claims, noticing and administrative agent for the Debtor in the above-captioned cases. I submit this supplemental certificate in connection with the service of solicitation materials (the “**Solicitation Packages**”) for the *Second Amended Plan of Reorganization, as Modified, for Sepco Corporation Under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code* [Docket No. 664] (the “**Plan**”). I am over the age of 18 and not a party to this action. Except as otherwise noted, I could and would testify to the following based upon my personal knowledge.

2. On February 12, 2016, the Court entered the *Order Authorizing and Approving the Retention and Employment of Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC as Notice, Balloting, and Claims Agent for the Debtor-in-Possession* [Docket No. 44].

3. Consistent with its retention as noticing, balloting and claims agent, KCC is charged with, among other things, the duty of printing and distributing Solicitation Packages to creditors and other interested parties pursuant to the instructions set forth in the *Motion of the Debtor for an Order Approving (I) the Disclosure Statement; (II) the Solicitation and Voting Procedures; (III) Forms of Ballots; (IV) Deadlines and Procedures to File Objections to the Disclosure Statement and the Plan; (V) a Hearing Date to Consider Confirmation of the Plan; and (VI) the Form, Scope, and Manner of Notice of the Plan and Confirmation Hearing* [Docket No. 527] (the “**Motion**”) filed by the Debtor on February 11, 2019 and the *Order (I) Approving the Adequacy of the Disclosure Statement; (II) Approving the Procedures to Solicit Acceptances of the Proposed Plan; (III) Approving Forms of Ballots Relating to the Plan; (IV) Establishing Deadlines and Procedures to File Objections to the Disclosure Statement and the Plan; (V) Scheduling a Hearing Date to Consider Confirmation of the Plan; and (VI) Approving the Form, Scope, and Manner of Notice of the Plan and Confirmation Hearing* [Docket No. 669] (the “**Solicitation Procedures Order**”), as entered by the Court on December 16, 2019.

4. The Solicitation Packages consist of the following documents:

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- a. if applicable, a flash drive (the “**Flash Drive**”) containing the following documents:
- i. the *Disclosure Statement with Respect to the Second Amended Plan of Reorganization, as Modified, for Sepco Corporation Under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code* [Docket No. 665];
 - ii. the Plan;
 - iii. the Solicitation Procedures Order, with the Voting Procedures appended as Exhibit 1 (but without any other exhibits);
 - iv. the *Notice of Voting Rights and Hearing to Confirm to the Plan of Reorganization* [Docket No. 690] (the “**Confirmation Hearing Notice**”); and
 - v. Letter to Creditors of Sepco Corporation
- b. either a printed copy of the appropriate Ballot(s) and voting instructions for the voting class in which the creditor is entitled to vote:
