**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ORDER SHORTENING NOTICE
AND EXPEDITING HEARING ON FIRST-DAY MOTIONS AND
SCHEDULING HEARING ON FIRST DAY MOTIONS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on July 30, 2015 (the "**Petition Date**"), Southern Regional Health System, Inc., d/b/a Southern Regional Medical Center ("**Southern Regional**"), Southern Crescent Physicians' Group, Inc., ("**SCPG**"), Southern Crescent Real Estate, Inc., ("**SCRE**"), Southern Regional Ambulatory Surgery, Inc., ("**SRAS**"), Southlake Ambulatory Surgery Center, L.L.L.P., d/b/a Mount Zion Surgery Center, a/k/a Spivey Station Surgery Center ("**Spivey Station**") and Southern Regional Medical Services, Inc., ("**SRMS**"), debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the "**Debtors**"), each filed a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "**Bankruptcy Code**") with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Georgia, Atlanta Division (the "**Bankruptcy Court**").

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, together with their petitions, the Debtors also filed their Motion for Order Shortening Notice and Expediting Hearing on First-Day Motions ("**Motion for Expedited Hearing**") in which the Debtors have requested that the Court



hear and consider on an expedited basis the Motions set forth on the attached Index of First Day Motions (collectively, the “**First Day Motions**”).

For cause shown, the Court hereby grants the Motion for Expedited Hearing as set forth below.

IT IS ORDERED AND NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, that a hearing will be held before the Court on the **4th day of August, 2015, at 9:30 a.m.**, in Courtroom 1403, United States Courthouse, 75 Spring Street, SW, Atlanta, Georgia to consider the First Day Motions.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that copies of the First Day Motions shall be made available as follows: (i) upon written request to the Debtors’ proposed counsel of record listed below; (ii) at the website of the Debtors’ proposed claims and noticing agent, Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC (“**KCC**”) (www.kccllc.net/southernregional); (iii) by request via email to KCC at southernregionalinfo@kccllc.com; and/or (iv) in the office of the Clerk, U.S. Bankruptcy Court between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. or online anytime at <http://ecf.ganb.uscourts.gov> (registered users) or at <http://pacer.psc.uscourts.gov> (unregistered users). No further notice shall be required.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that counsel for the Debtors shall serve a copy of this Order and Notice of Hearing by hand delivery, facsimile, electronic mail, overnight courier (where a street address is available) or by next-day United States mail upon the Office of the United States Trustee, counsel to the Debtors’ pre-petition secured lender, counsel to the Debtors’ proposed debtor-in-possession lender, any other party asserting a security interest in assets of the Debtors, and the Debtors’ thirty (30) largest unsecured creditors on a consolidated basis and file a certificate of such service.
