**ORDER ESTABLISHING DEADLINE FOR FILING REQUESTS FOR PAYMENT OF
ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE CLAIMS INCLUDING
CLAIMS PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 503(B)(9)**

This matter is before the Court on the Motion to Set Administrative Claims Bar Date (the “**Motion**”) [Doc. No. 610] filed on April 6, 2016, by the above-captioned Chapter 11 debtors (the “**Debtors**”). The Court has considered the Motion. It appears that the Court has jurisdiction over this proceeding; that this is a core proceeding; that notice of this Motion has been provided to the proper parties; that no further notice is necessary; that the relief sought in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors, their estates, and their creditors; and good and sufficient cause exists for such relief.



Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. All individuals and entities that have or assert any claims against the Debtors pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 503(b)(9) with regard to goods delivered to and received by the Debtors between July 10, 2015 and July 30, 2015 (the “**Petition Date**”) (the “**503(b)(9) Claims**”), **must** file a request for allowance of such claims pursuant to the terms of this Order.
3. All individuals and entities that have or assert any claims against the Debtors pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 503, other than 503(b)(9) Claims and other than as set forth below in Paragraph 6 of this Order, that arose between the Petition Date and April 1, 2016 (the “**Administrative Claims**”), **must** file a request for allowance of such claims pursuant to the terms of this Order.
4. All requests for allowance of 503(b)(9) Claims and Administrative Claims addressed by this Order must be filed **no later than June 30, 2016** (the “**Administrative Claims Bar Date**”).
5. Any claimant that does not file a request for allowance of its Administrative Claims or 503(b)(9) Claims by the Administrative Claims Bar Date **may be forever barred from any recovery for any such claim.**
6. This Order does not apply to any request for compensation and reimbursement of expenses under 11 U.S.C. §§ 330(a), 503(b)(2), and 503(b)(4), nor to any request for allowance of an Administrative Claim or a 503(b)(9) Claim that has already been filed in the above-captioned case.
7. The form of the Bar Date Notice, the Administrative Claim Form, the 503(b)(9) Claim Form, and the Publication Notice (as such terms are defined in the Motion) are approved.

8. The service and notice procedures requested in the Motion are approved and such procedures are reasonable and will provide good, adequate, sufficient, and proper notice to all claimants of (i) the Administrative Claims Bar Date and (ii) such claimants' rights and obligations in connection with the Administrative Claims and 503(b)(9) Claims they may have against the Debtors in these chapter 11 cases.

9. The Debtors are authorized to publish notice of the Administrative Claims Bar Date in the form of the Publication Notice in (i) the **Atlanta Journal Constitution**, and (ii) the **Clayton News Daily** for three (3) days no later than thirty (30) days prior to the Administrative Claims Bar Date.

10. All parties reserve the right to review and object to any Administrative Claims or 503(b)(9) Claims filed.

11. Counsel for the Debtors shall promptly serve a copy of this Order on the Office of the United States Trustee, counsel for the Committee, counsel for Prime, and the master service list established in these bankruptcy cases. Counsel for the Debtors shall file a certificate of such service.
