**UNITED STATES TRUSTEE’S MOTION
FOR LEAVE OF COURT TO FILE EXPANDED BRIEF**

COMES NOW Nancy J. Gargula, United States Trustee for Region 21, (the “United States Trustee”), through undersigned counsel, and states as follows:

1. On January 31, 2020, GGG Partners, LLC, in its capacity as the liquidating trustee for the Clayton General Liquidating Trust (the “Liquidating Trustee”), filed its Application for Final Decree, Final Report of Substantial Consummation, Request for Final Decree, and Motion to Determine Fees Payable to the United States Trustee Program (the “Motion”) (Docket No. 1360).
2. Because the Motion raises multiple complex constitutional issues, the United States Trustee believes she cannot adequately respond to the Motion in the twenty-five page limit set forth in BLR 7007-1(e).
3. Consequently, the United States Trustee respectfully requests leave of Court to file a response to the Motion not to exceed 50 pages, and further requests leave of Court to allow the Liquidating Trustee to file a reply to any such response not to exceed 25 pages.
4. The Liquidating Trustee consents to the relief requested in the United States Trustee’s Motion For Leave Of Court To File Expanded Brief.
