ORDER GRANTING COMPLEX CHAPTER 11 BANKRUPTCY CASE TREATMENT

These jointly administered cases were filed on May 10, 2020. A *Notice of Designation as Complex Chapter 11 Bankruptcy Case* (the "Notice")² was filed. Based on its review of the initial pleadings, the Court concludes that the complex chapter 11 case designation is appropriate. Accordingly, the Court orders:

 - b. The Local Rules for the U.S. District Court of the Southern District of Texas (the "Local District Court Civil Rules") rule 83.1 applies.
 - c. Appendix A to the Local District Court Civil Rules applies.
